**Subject:** EMD FYI - NC State of Emergency (Charlotte Civil Disturbance)

Last night, NC Governor McCrory declared a State of Emergency, activated the National Guard, and implemented the State Emergency Operations Plan, which was done at the request of local law enforcement to respond to the civil disturbances following the death from an officer related shooting.

Kim Stenson has contacted the NC EMD Director and also the York County EM Director. No specific support requests have been made to York County at this time, but they have a long-standing mutual aid agreement with Charlotte-Mecklenburg if assistance is required. Stenson projects that the likelihood for any state assistance requests for support from NC is low, but he would not completely rule out some limited support requests.
