To celebrate their role at the 2013 Hilton Head Island Motoring Festival & Concours d'Elegance, their first time at the event, the Manns have chosen to showcase three of the four cars that were selected as Best of Show, including: a 1934 Voisin Roadster, a 1937 Delage D8-120 Aerodynamic Coupe and a 1938 Delage D8-120 DeVillars Cabriolet.
