PIER PRESSURE! How many fishing piers have resided at Myrtle Beach State Park? You may be surprised to learn the number is 4. Our first pier was built in 1950 in front of the current cabins on the north end of the park. Hurricane Hazel demolished that pier in 1954 and it was rebuilt. In 1958, an Air Force training jet crashed into the pier parking lot killing 2 people. Since this pier was in the main flight path of the air base across the road, it was decided to relocate the pier to its current location. Hurricane Hugo destroyed all the Grand Strand piers in 1989 and our current pier was rebuilt in 1992. Enjoy a walk on our pier- you never know what you will see- birds, dolphins, sea turtles, sharks, jellyfish or a fisherman reeling in a catch of a lifetime!
