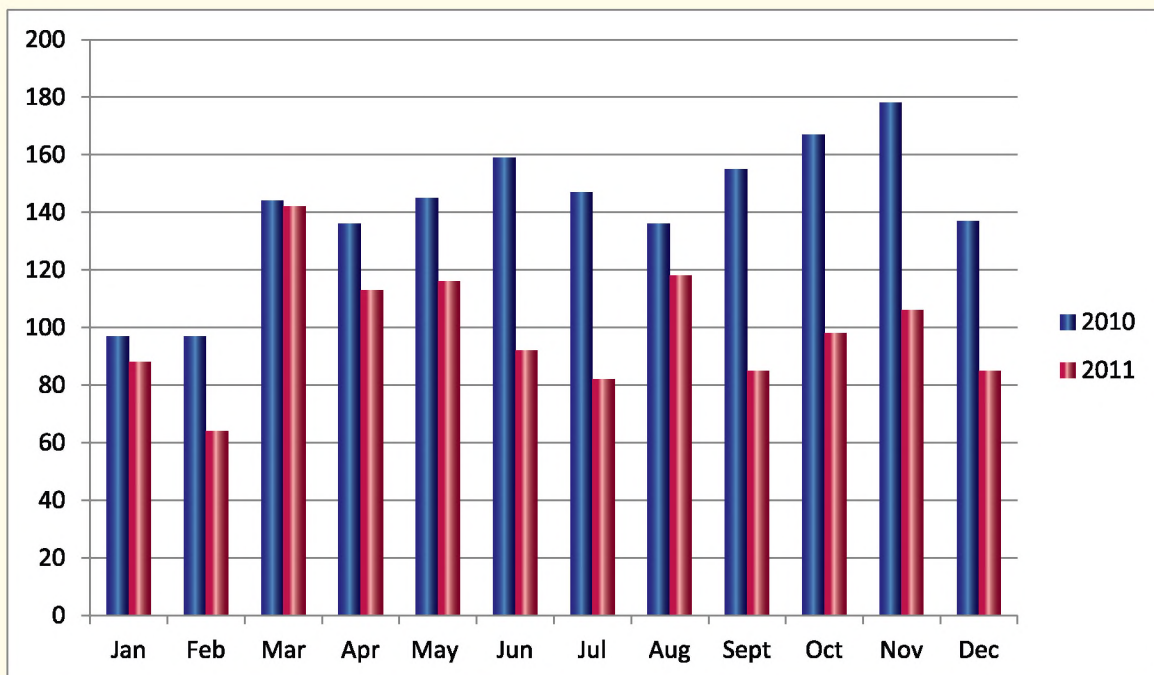

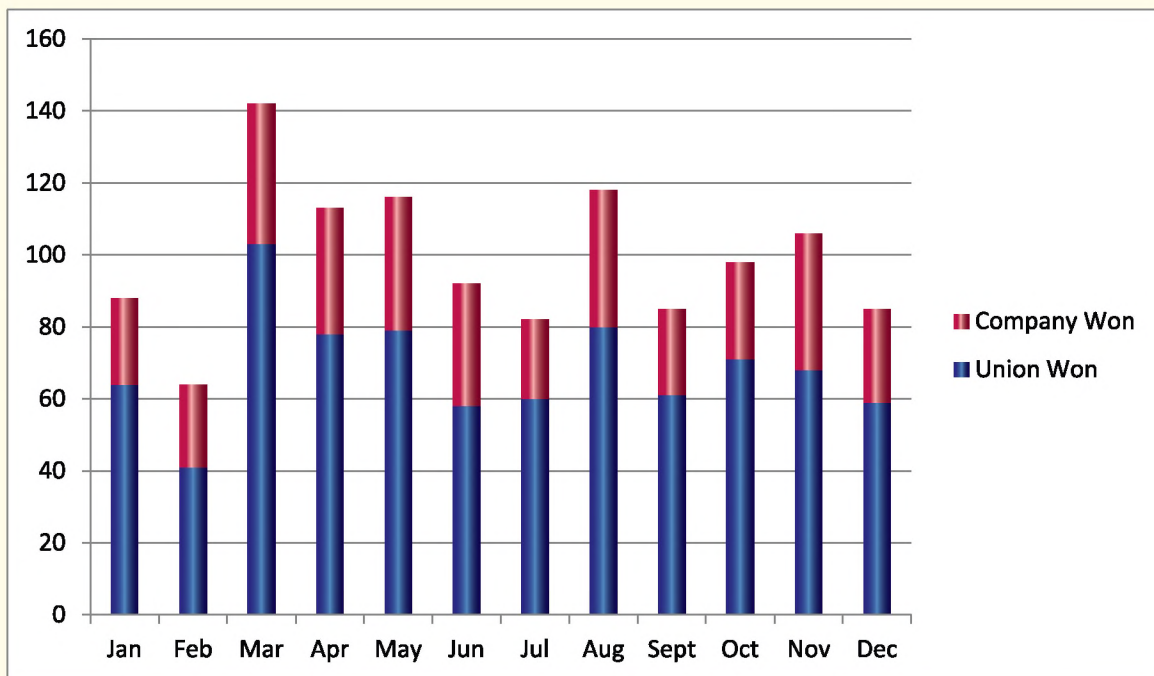
## NLRB Representation Elections

A total of 1,189 representation elections were resolved for all unions during 2011. This represents a decrease of 30.0% compared to 2010. Unions won 69.1% of all representation elections during 2011, up from 67.2% during 2010. As a result of those elections, unions organized a total of 50,828 workers.

## Total Number of Representation Elections Held in 2011



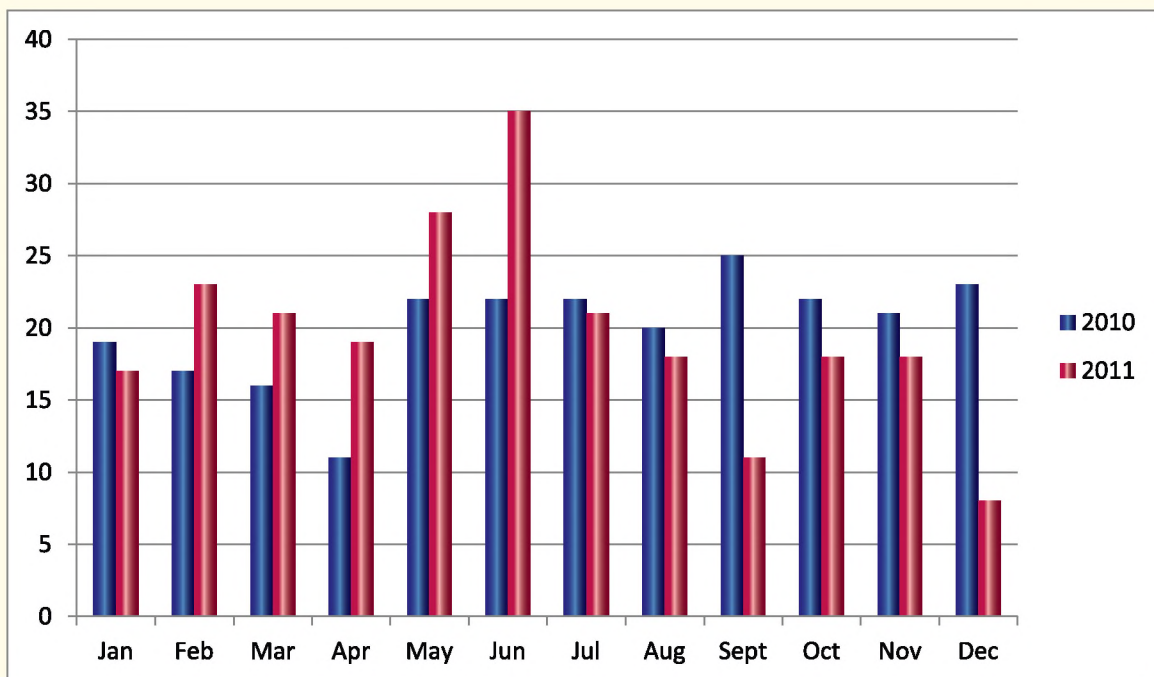
## Company/Union Wins Representation Elections



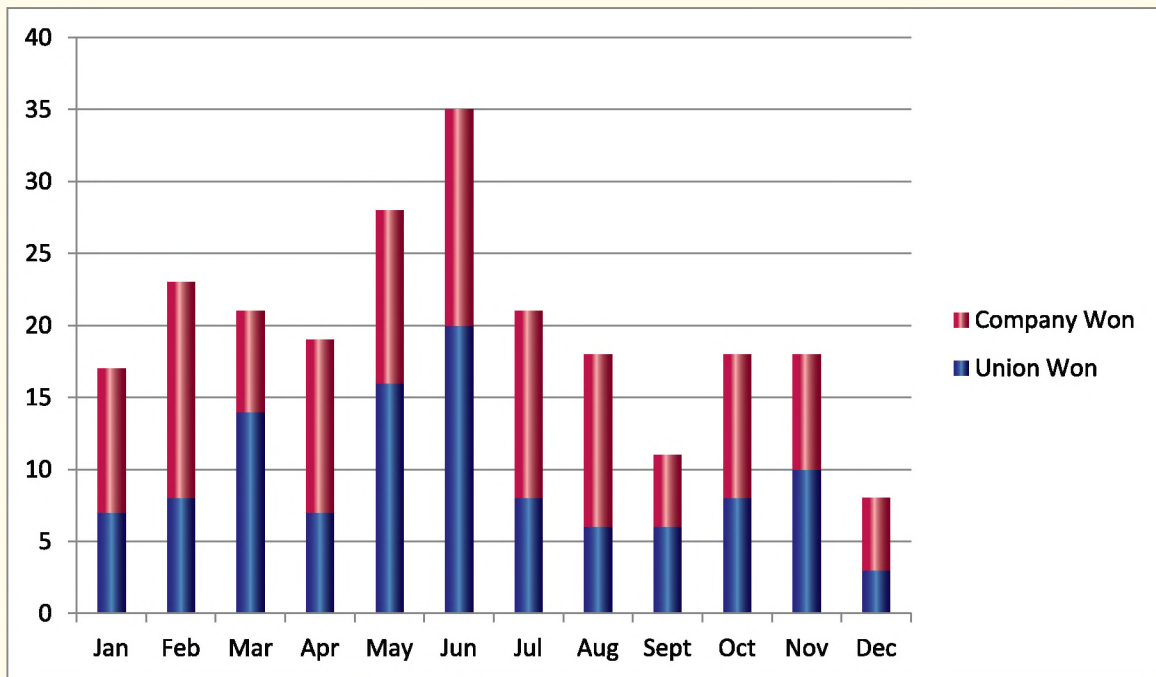
## NLRB Decertification Elections

A total of 237 decertification elections were resolved for all unions during 2011, a decrease of 1.3% compared to 2010. Unions won 47.7% of all decertification elections during 2011, up from 38.3% during 2010. As a result of those elections, unions lost a total of 5,968 workers.

## Total Number of Decertification Elections Held



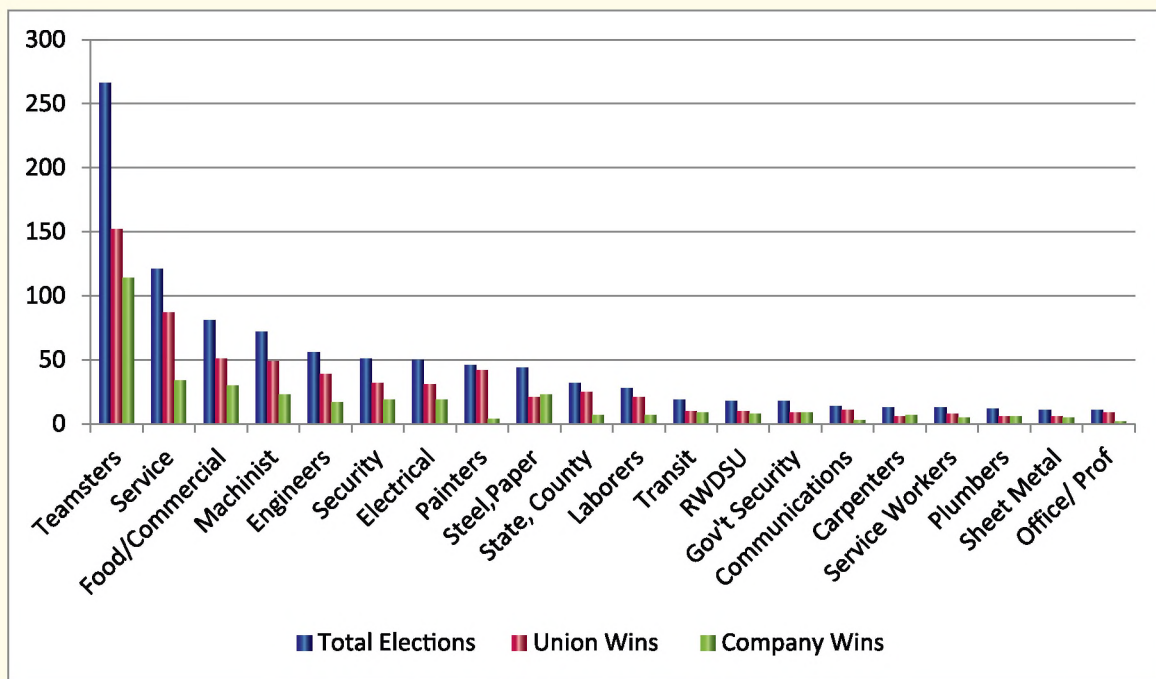
## Decertification Elections Company/Union Wins

## Most Active Unions

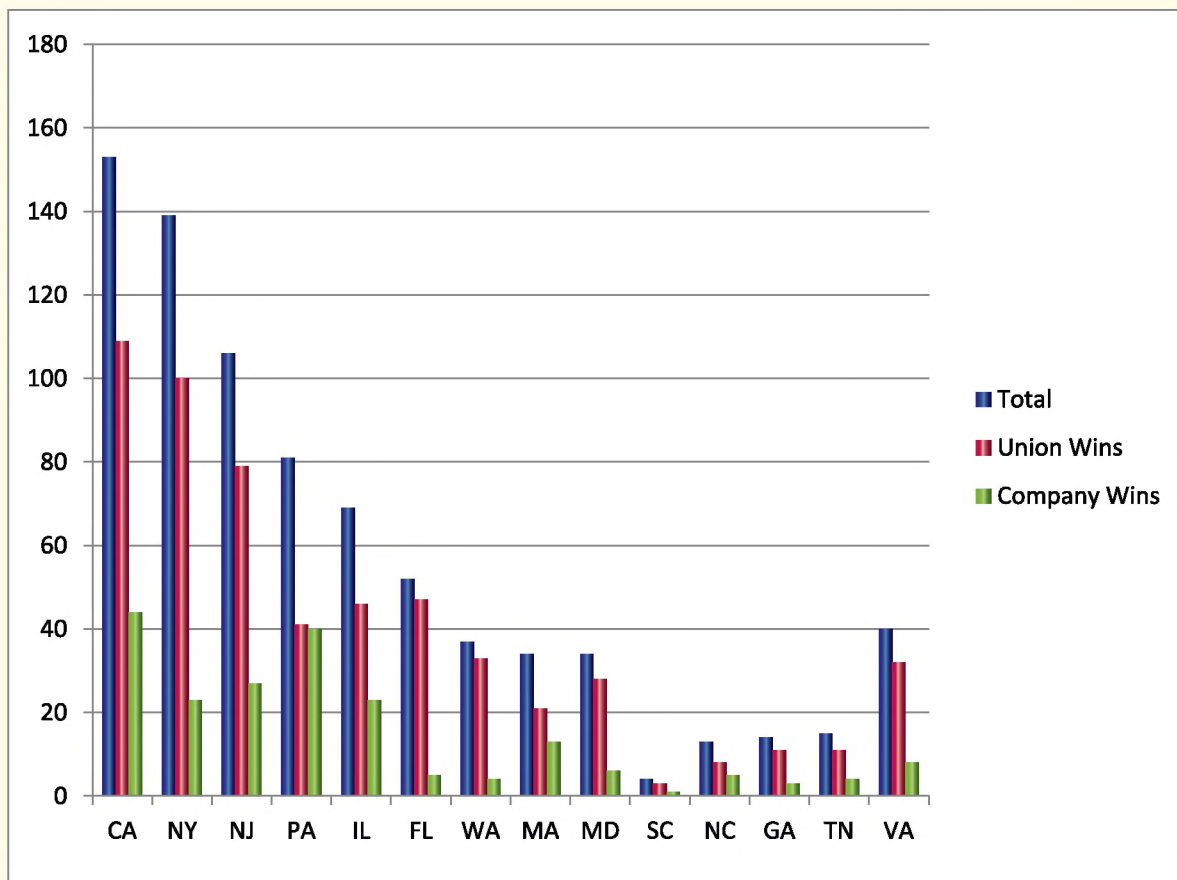
The Teamsters union was the most active, having been involved in a total of 266 representation elections certified during 2011.

## Elections per State

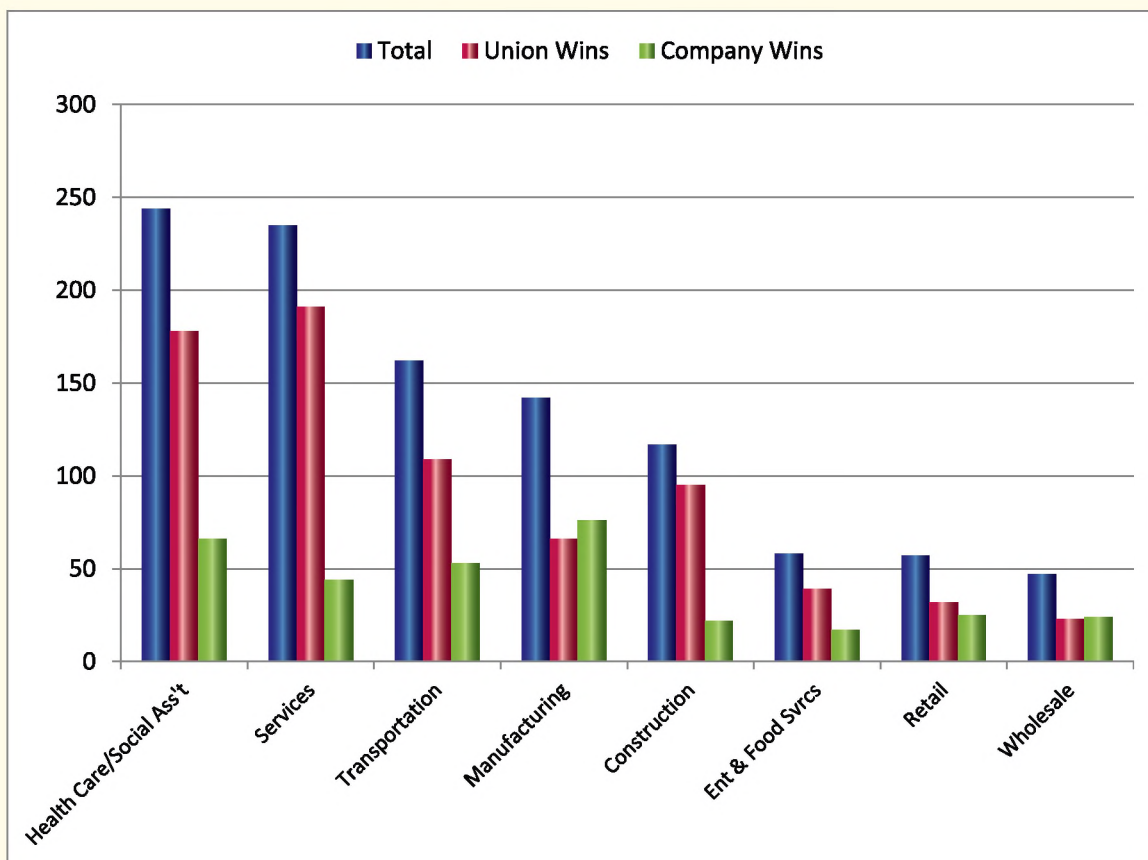
The states with the highest number of representation elections resolved during 2011 were California, with 153 elections and New York with 139 elections.





## Elections by Industry Type

Unions had the most success in the Finance, Insurance, Real Estate industries, winning 90.5% of RC elections during 2011. Unions found the least success in the Agriculture industry, winning 0% of those RC elections.





## Elections per Unit Size

Voters in a unit size between 1 and 10 were the most likely to vote in favor of the union in representation elections during 2011, with unions winning 80.1% of those elections.
