SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of May 6, 2004; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the sale of surplus right of way property, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to advertise and select consultants to provide structural steel and concrete inspection services on an "on call" basis, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to advertise and select a consulting firm or firms for the purpose of providing engineering services for the replacement of various bridges in the state, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending an existing bituminous retreatment contract to include additional resurfacing work, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending existing construction contracts to include additional work, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending a contract beyond the contract limits, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in transferring a road from the State Highway Secondary to the State Highway Primary System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in removing roads from the State Highway System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion correcting the descriptions of roads previously added to the State Highway System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 11: The Commission unanimously passed a motion adding roads to the State Highway System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 12: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department concerning projects in the April 13 and May 11, 2004 highway lettings as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 13: Commissioner Jones reported for the Invitations and Resolutions subcommittee and made a motion to approve twenty-five (25) resolutions. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Turner and passed unanimously by the Commission. A complete listing of the resolutions, as well as copies of the resolutions, are shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 14: Commissioner Hardee reported for the Mass Transit Subcommittee and made a motion requesting the full Commission approve the creation of the upstate high speed rail corridor task force. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Carnell and passed unanimously by the Commission

SECTION 15: Commissioner Carnell reported for the Finance and Administration Subcommittee and made a motion requesting that the full Commission adopt the FY 04-05 Operating Budget and the FY 05-06 Appropriations Budget as submitted and shown in detail in the Appendix. Commissioner Jones seconded the motion and the Commission unanimously approved

SECTION 16: On motion of Commissioner Jones, seconded by Commissioner Turner, the Commission unanimously passed a motion excusing the absence of Commissioner Truluck due to technical difficulties with the telephone conference call.

SECTION 17: On motion of Commissioner Hardee, seconded by Commissioner Turner, the Commission unanimously passed a motion to go into Executive Session.

Surplus Property Public Notice

June 16, 2004

In accordance with the State of South Carolina Statute 57-5-340, by this publication the Department is making public the Surplus Property Real Estate Transactions to the State Highway Commission. The following sheets include a breakdown of surplus property real estate transactions. These transactions may have resulted from negotiations with property owners during right of way acquisition, direct sales, settlement of a condemnation action, and/or corrective actions to previously reported sales.

1. File 23.537.1 / I-85 / SC Rte 146 Interchange / Greenville County / Fourth Congressional District

During construction of improvements on Road S-326, under File 23.537.1 in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-326, by Right of Way Easement from Nylon Industries, Inc. dated September 29, 1964.

The Department entered into an agreement with the Grantee, to sell a parcel of the old Frontage Road right of way. The Grantee is to build a new entrance, relocate the Frontage Road, and convey it to the county or city. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.5 acres of land to Point Development, LLC in consideration of \$90,000.00 and fee interest in the remaining Frontage Road was executed on April 26, 2004.

2. File 7.349 / Rd S-228 (National Street) / Beaufort County / Second Congressional District

During construction of improvements on Road S-228 (National Street), under File 7.349 in Beaufort County, near the City of Beaufort, the Department acquired right of way for National Street, by Dedication from the City of Beaufort dated April 10, 1962.

A request was received from the National Cemetery Administration Department of Veteran Affairs asking the Department to provide a quitclaim deed for a portion of National Street in order to allow the Department of Veteran Affairs to expand the National Cemetery. The cemetery wall is 12 feet from the center of the road and old graves are located within the 66-foot right of way. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 2.03 acres of land to the City of Beaufort was executed on May 11, 2004.

3. File 35.487.4 / SC Rte 38 & Rd S-381/Marlboro County / Fifth Congressional District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 38, under File 35.487.4 in Marlboro County, near the Town of Blenheim, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 38, by Title to Real Estate from L.C. Carabo dated February 20, 1996 and by the Beltline Act dated 1920.

DEA Townsend received a request from the Pleasant Hill Missionary Baptist Church asking the Department to sell a piece of surplus right of way adjacent to the church's property. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.49 of an acre of land to Pleasant Hill Missionary Baptist Church in consideration of \$1,000.00 was executed on May 11, 2004.

4. File 23.188A / US Rte 25 & Reloc. Rd S-541/ Greenville County / Fourth Congressional District

During construction of improvements on US Route 25 and Road S-541, under File 23.188A in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way for US Route 25 & Relocated Road S-541, by Condemnation from Betty Howard Trotter, et al dated October 9, 1989.

The Department previously conveyed the subject parcel to Mr. Joseph R. and Peggy H. Chambers on February 27, 1992 in consideration of \$195.00. Since that time, the deed has been misplaced and a request was received by the Grantee asking the Department to prepare a replacement deed. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1,950 square feet (0.04 Acres) of land to Joseph R. and Peggy H. Chambers was executed on May 12, 2004.

5. File 2.893 / SC Rte 302, SC Rte 4 & Rd S-53 / Aiken County / Second Congressional District

During construction of improvements to the intersection involving SC Route 302, SC Route 4 and Road S-53, under File 2.893, in Aiken County, in the unincorporated area of Kitchens Mill, the Department acquired right of way, by Title to Real Estate from Ruthanne McNair Lucius dated April 5, 1999.

During negotiations to acquire the new right of way needed for the above referenced project, the Department agreed to convey any surplus right of way, not needed to support the relocated road, to the Grantee at project completion. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.19 acres of land to Ruthanne McNair Lucius was executed on May 24, 2004.

6. File 32.546.3 / SC Route 12 & 9th Street Ext. / Lexington County / Second Congressional District

During construction of improvements on 9th Street Extension, under File 32.546.3 in Lexington County, near the Town of West Columbia, the Department acquired right of way for 9th Street Extension, by Right of Way Easement from Mary Elizabeth Manus dated March 7, 1974.

A request was received from the Personal Representatives for The Estate of Warren S. Smith, asking the Department to sell a small piece of surplus property. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.06 of an acre of land to Warren Smith was executed on May 24, 2004 in consideration of \$250.00.

Professional Services Recommendations

June 16, 2004

The following sheets include recommendations for the Department to utilize professional consulting firms to provide various services, which may include design, right of way acquisitions, construction engineering and inspection, or other associated services. The Department requests approval from the Commission to advertise, select and negotiate for these necessary services.

**“On Call” Structural Steel and
Concrete Inspection Consultant(s)**

South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) requests Commission Approval to advertise and select consultant(s) to provide Structural Steel and Concrete Inspection services on an “On Call” basis. The contract will be for a period not to exceed three (3) years. Services will be provided for statewide projects. The funding source will be both State and Federal. The total estimated cost for the three (3) year period is \$ 300,000.

REQUEST FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR:

BRIDGES IN VARIOUS COUNTIES

These projects will be funded through Bridge Replacement Program.

- 1] SC 49: Bridges over Warrior Creek and Enoree River in Laurens and Spartanburg Counties (3rd & 4th Congressional Districts)
- 2] SC 133: Bridge over Twelve Mile Creek /Lake Hartwell in Pickens County (3rd Congressional District)
- 3] S-75: Bridge over US 29 in Anderson County (3rd Congressional District)
- 4] S-605: Bridge over Fairforest Creek in Spartanburg County (4th Congressional District)

The Department requests Commission approval to advertise and select a consulting firm or firms for the purpose of providing engineering services for the replacement of the above bridges. Based on current and projected workload, the Department does not have sufficient staff to proceed with these projects.

EXTENSION OF BITUMINOUS RESURFACING CONTRACT

TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL RESURFACING WORK

It is recommended that the Commission approve the action of the Department in extending an existing bituminous retreatment contract to include additional resurfacing work as follows:

Contract of APAC Atlantic, Inc. - File No. 14.29039 - extended to include full depth patching (File No. 14.29039) of J. W. Rhames Road for 4.1 miles.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 33,288.00

This extension was authorized by the Department prior to formal approval by the Commission since the adjacent work had reached such a stage of completion that the contractor involved could not accept the additional work unless it were authorized without delay.

Contract of APAC Atlantic, Inc. – File No. 21.157B - extended to include an additional section of Project FAP STP-RFMT(189) (File No. 21.157B) consisting of resurfacing at intersection of US 301/52 and SC 327 in Effingham.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 10,434.30

GREENVILLE COUNTY: (Commissioner William Turner)

Contract of Ashmore Brothers, Inc. – File No. 23.205B – extended to include an additional section of Project FAP NH-RFMT(275) (File No. 4.149B) consisting of resurfacing of S-102 from US 276 to 1.5 miles past US 276.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$140,470.65

LEXINGTON COUNTY: (Commissioner John Hardee)

Contract of Rea Contracting LLC - File No. 32.197B - extended to include an additional section of Project FAP IM-IM88(014) (File No. 32.197B) consisting of performing cross slope correction work on a section of I-26 in Lexington.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 25,554.75

YORK COUNTY: (Commissioner Bobby Jones)

Contract of APAC Atlantic, Inc. - File No. 46.164B - extended to include an additional section of State Project SRP-164B (File 46.135B) consisting of resurfacing on S-277 (Academy Street) for 0.55 mile.

Estimated Cost of Extension: \$93,548.26

These extensions were authorized by the Department prior to formal approval by the Commission since the adjacent work had reached such a stage of completion that the contractors involved could not accept the additional work unless it were authorized without delay.

EXTENSION OF A CONTRACT BEYOND CONTRACT LIMITS

It is recommended that the Commission approve the extension of the following contract beyond the contract limits as follows:

BERKELEY COUNTY: (Commissioner Robert Harrell, Sr.)

Contract of Banks Construction Company, Inc. - File No. 8.787 - extended to include an additional section of Project FAP BNH-CHMB(003) (File No. 8.787) consisting of extension of project limit on Road S-29 for approximately 650' to rebuild the section from the Goose Creek Bridge to the new construction (this ties into S-43 in Charleston County).

Estimated Cost of Extension

\$ 183,228.37

This extension is being requested in order to take advantage of lower unit prices available in this contract as opposed to other contracts currently available for extension in Berkeley County.

Transfer of Road between Secondary and Primary Systems

June 16, 2004

The Department recommends Commission approval to transfer sections of road from the Secondary System to the Primary System, or vice versa. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 57-5-50 of the Code-of-Laws of South Carolina, 1976, the Commission may transfer any route or section of route from the state highway secondary system to the state highway primary system, or vice versa, when, in its judgment, such transfer is advisable to better serve the traveling public.

Detailed information concerning each of these requests is attached.

Transfer from the Secondary to the Primary System

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 57-5-50 of the Code-of-Laws of South Carolina, 1976, it is recommended that the below described section of road be transferred from the State Highway Secondary System to the State Primary System as follows:

Removal of Roads From State Highway Secondary System

June 16, 2004

The Department recommends Commission approval for the removal of certain sections of secondary roads from the State Highway Secondary System. These sections of roads may be removed for one of the following reasons:

1. Abandonment of Relocated Section of Highway
2. Deletions and Removal of Roads from State Secondary System - Roads may be deleted and removed from secondary system by exchanging for equal or less mileage or roads, which have a higher traffic importance. Ownership reverts to local government having jurisdiction (city or county). Approval of deletion or removal by local government is not required.
3. Abandonment of Right-of-way - Right-of-way may be abandoned if it is determined that the right-of-way is not required for right-of-way proposes or if the right-of-way is not needed for Department purposes.
4. Court Order

Whereas, George and his father, Thomas, who accompanied him on his adventure to the new world purchased 250 acres of the 288 acre Jeremiah Roach land grant property in Long Creek in 1885 for two hundred dollars. Thomas returned to England where he died in 1901, leaving the land to George; and

Whereas, this land is the center of Long Creek today, around which the community is formed. Most of the acreage remains in the Matheson family of descendants up to the great, great, great descendants of the Oconee County pioneer; and

Whereas, the Long Creek fire station and community building rest on five acres that the Matheson children sold to Oconee County for the erection of the Long Creek Elementary School. When school consolidation made the building obsolete, it was converted to its present use; and

Whereas, George built Matheson's Store in the heart of Long Creek in the late 1890's or early 1900's. He was a gentleman whose appearance one never forgot. With his full-face beard, English accent, English plaid cap and unpressed pants, he spoke in a gentle manner, always with grace and integrity. With a cigar held firmly between his teeth, he spread his influence near and far; and

Whereas, his store was the only general store-gasoline station between Westminster and Clayton, Georgia, for many years. It enabled residents to purchase essential goods and gasoline without the time and expense of travel; and

Whereas, George was named Long Creek postmaster in 1920 and served for 17 years, until 1937, when he suffered a stroke and was forced to retire. The position of postmaster stayed in the Matheson family, when son, Charles, was named to the post. When Charles retired, his brother, Nelson Matheson, was named postmaster. He served until 1964. For 44 years, a Matheson was postmaster; and

Whereas, the first landmark in the Long Creek community is Matheson's Store and named in the

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outh Carolina General Assembly - Legislative Printing, Information and Technology Systems
 whereas, the first telephone in the Long Creek area was in Matheson's store and served as the
 community phone; and

Whereas, George first taught students of all ages in a small school in Long Creek. Educated in
 England, it was said that he was the most educated man in those mountains; and

Whereas, George was Justice of the Peace, whether he was meting out justice or marring local
 couples, he gave out advice, filled out legal papers, and gave assistance in a community where many
 were unable to read or write; and

Whereas, George not only taught in a small Long Creek school, but he was a part of the effort to
 bring education to mountain children when he joined the Reverend L. H. Raines in founding Long
 Creek Academy. He was the first secretary of the founding organization according to a story in the
 archives of the Keowee Courier, a newspaper published in Walhalla since the 1850's. Several of the
 Matheson siblings graduated from this school before furthering their education at Furman
 University; and

Whereas, this man of the mountains, and English immigrant, was a pioneer in making Long Creek
 an apple-growing region in South Carolina. He and his father-in-law, Nathaniel Shedd, whose farm
 joined the Matheson's on the west, were leaders in this movement and for many years, the
 Matheson-Shedd apple orchards were the first thing one saw surrounding Matheson's Store on all
 sides as one drove into Long Creek; and

Whereas, descendants of this remarkable man and his wife, Mary Ann, have enriched Oconee
 County, the State, and our country. There are doctors, lawyers, educators, business owners,
 government officials and employees, firemen, police officers, mill workers, farmers, orchardists,
 career military, and others who claim the Matheson legacy; and

Whereas, given the profound impact the Matheson family has had throughout our state's history, it

Whereas, the members of the General Assembly were deeply saddened upon the death of Garrett Patrick Wonders of Goose Creek on Wednesday, March 10, 2004, at the age of twenty-five, when he was hit by a truck while riding his bicycle on Old Highway 52; and

Whereas, born in Warren, Ohio, to John and Shelley Wonders, Garrett graduated magna cum laude from Ohio State University in May of 2000, and married Terri Elliott on June 24, 2000. He went on to receive his Masters in Engineering from Ohio State University in May of 2001; and

Whereas, on July 23, 2001, Garrett Wonders was commissioned as an Ensign in the United States Navy and assigned as an instructor at the Naval Nuclear Power Training Command in Charleston; and

Whereas, an exceptional athlete who competed in marathons, triathlons, and adventure races, Garrett's true passion was cycling. He was a member of the 2003 United States Elite National Military Cycling Team and was training for the United States Olympic Trials and the 2004 United States Cycling Federation Elite National Road Championships in Redlands, California; and

Whereas, a vital part of the local cycling community, Garrett not only promoted cycling, but also encouraged good will, kindness, and friendliness among cyclists and the community; and

Whereas, Garrett Wonders is survived by his wife; parents; one brother, Jesse Wonders, and his wife, Jennifer; grandparents Herbert and Betty Daugherty and William and Patricia Wonders; and other loving family members; and

Whereas, it is appropriate that the members of the General Assembly request that the Department of Transportation name the bicycle-pedestrian lane of the new Arthur Ravenel, Jr. Bridge in memory of such an exemplary South Carolinian as Garrett Patrick Wonders. Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

That the members of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, by this resolution, request that the Department of Transportation name the bicycle-pedestrian lane of the new Arthur Ravenel, Jr. Bridge the Garrett P. 
