Azamara will dry-dock its two 686-passenger ships early next year for it calls "complete makeovers." Azamara Journey will undergo refurbishments in January, and sister ship Azamara Quest will receive its face-lift in April.

Public spaces, dining venues, spas and all staterooms and suites will be upgraded. A new, open-air Pan-Asian restaurant -- incorporating Chinese, Japanese, Thai and Korean cuisines -- will be added to the ship's culinary offerings.

In my newsletter on small-ship cruising earlier this month, I mentioned that **Star Clippers** plans to build a new vessel, its first new-build in 15 years. Here are a few more details about that ship.

Like others in the fleet, it will be a masted sailing ship -- specifically, a five-masted, square rigged barque. Carrying 300 passengers and powered by more than 6,350 square meters of sails, the new addition will be the largest ship of its kind.

All of Star Clippers' ships are modeled on famed vessels of the past. The new ship will be based on the France II, a cargo carrier built in 1911 and the second-largest commercial sailing ship ever built. It also had a handful of luxury passenger cabins; among the amenities available for travelers were a darkroom, library and "seawater therapy treatment."

Its modern-day counterpart -- scheduled to launch in the second half of 2017 -- will include 34 balcony suites in its accommodations and will sport a water-sports platform.
