## 10/20/2016 SCEMD Hurricane Matthew Recovery Update

### Public Assistance and Individual Assistance Declarations

- ☐ **Federal disaster declarations for Public Assistance (governments and some private entities)** have been made for the following counties:
  - Categories A-G: Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Beaufort, Berkeley, Colleton, Dillon, Dorchester, Florence, Georgetown, Hampton, Horry, Jasper, Lee, Marion, Orangeburg, Sumter, and Williamsburg
  - Categories A and B: Calhoun, Charleston, Clarendon, Darlington, and Marlboro
  - **SCEMD is working closely with FEMA to process requests for private property debris removal.** To date SCEMD has received requests from the Town of Hilton Head Island, Beaufort County, Georgetown County, and Horry County.
- ☐ **Federal disaster declarations for Individual Assistance (to individuals who have sustained losses due to the storm)** have been made for Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Beaufort, Calhoun, Clarendon, Colleton, Darlington, Dillon, Dorchester, Florence, Georgetown, Hampton, Horry, Jasper, Lee, Marion, Marlboro, Orangeburg, Sumter, and Williamsburg.

- ☐ ***To date, no counties have been denied Public Assistance or Individual Assistance declarations. We will continue to submit supporting documentation for counties to be added for Individual Assistance and Public Assistance based on ongoing Preliminary Damage Assessment data as it is available.***

**Major flooding continues in the Pee Dee region and Horry County.** The Waccamaw River is expected to remain above major flood stage through Tuesday, the Little Pee River at major flood through Thursday, and the Lumber River is currently in minor flood stage and expected to stay there through Sunday.

**State agencies continue to support local relief missions** in Dillon, Horry, and Marion counties where residents are either evacuated due to flooding or are in need of immediate relief supplies.

**25 dams have been breached**, 20 of which are state regulated and 5 unregulated. A list of breached dams can be found [here](#).

**820 storm-related power outages** remain statewide, mostly as a result of flood/wind damage.

**3 emergency shelters** remain open serving 151 occupants.
