All - I want to share an offer with each of you from our friends at Fort Jackson. They are sponsoring a "Meet your neighbors at Fort Jackson night". The evening will begin at the Officers' Club at Fort Jackson at 6:30PM on the 22rd of April. The Chain of Command will greet everyone and provide a brief overview on the status on training at Fort Jackson. The highlight of the evening will be a trip out to Fort Jackson's Night Infiltration Course.
