Commissioner's Column

Agriculture & Agribusiness Showcased at SC's Fairs

As the Thanksgiving season approaches, we are reminded of agriculture's abundance provided by our nation's farmers, particularly by South Carolina's farmers. Apples, sweet potatoes, pecans, and a diverse array of fall plants and flowers are visible at almost every turn. But, there is a wide variety of items produced from raw farm products---items that add value to agriculture.

While the South Carolina Department of Agriculture's State Fair exhibit highlighted crops grown in the state, the exhibit also showed a number of value-added products derived from those traditional crops. For example, some of the products using corn or corn by-products displayed were barbecue sauce, ketchup, corn flakes, vegetable oil, and cat food.

Items using cotton or cotton by-products in the display included potato chips, crackers, and cake mix. Also, flour, noodles, crackers, and dog food products were exhibited to show that they were derived from wheat or wheat by-products. In addition, cereal, butter, potato chips, vegetable oil, mayonnaise, and dog and cat food items were displayed to show their connection to soybeans or soybean by-products. But, the items in the exhibit were only a sample of the infinite number of products adding value to agriculture.

Agribusinesses, businesses using raw agricultural products to produce other goods or businesses servicing and supplying farmers, are a vital part of agriculture. In addition to food and fiber, many other items derived from plant and animal by-products and produced on the farm are the result of raw farm products. For instance, pharmaceuticals, adhesives, detergents, crayons, desks, textbooks, shampoo, cosmetics, fuel, lumber, and paints are all derived from raw agricultural products. And, farmers themselves depend on business and industry for equipment, seeds and feeds, and---one of the fastest growing tools for farmers today---computers.

And, there is a wide variety of specialty products derived from South Carolina agriculture. Agribusinesses throughout the state are developing niche products created specifically for South Carolina consumers.

The South Carolina Department of Agriculture was proud to be able to showcase agriculture and agribusiness to those who may be far-removed from rural life through the South Carolina State Fair exhibit along with the many other local and county fairs around the Palmetto State. Those who may have never been to a farm were able to get a bird's eye view of agriculture.

There were special exhibits at the State Fair exhibit for our smallest citizens. Large flats of soil were installed in the Department's exhibit which were planted with soybean, cotton, and wheat seeds. The children could see what the plants looked like as they grew during the ten days of the fair. Also, a flat of soil was left unseeded and filled with toy tractors and farm equipment in which the children were allowed to play. Children's information packets filled with coloring books, soybean crayons, and other items were also distributed. The State Fair was and is always a place for children of all ages.

In fact, State Fair officials have provided an office so that 4-H will have a year-round permanent presence on the fairgrounds. 4-H is an excellent program providing hands-on experience with agriculture for our children in urban and rural areas of the state.

No matter what age you are, the fair is the place each fall for everyone---the young and the young-at-heart. It's the one place that allows urban and rural people to come together for a time of fun, food, and fellowship. But, more importantly, it's a showcase for agriculture and agribusiness.

I salute the many, many people involved in coordinating all of the fairs throughout the state. And, while the fairs have ended until next year, remember that value-added products are an essential part of agriculture, that agriculture and agribusiness are interdependent, and that children of all ages enjoy the fruits of agriculture---from the apples in their lunch boxes to the pumpkin pie on the Thanksgiving table.
