ON 2/5/2016 AT APPROXIMATELY 2042 PM DEPUTIES WITH THE CHESTER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE WERE DISPATCHED TO 707 ANTLER DR IN RICHBURG, SC IN THE COUNTY OF CHESTER IN REFERENCE TO AN ASSAULT. UPON ARRIVAL DEPUTY JOAS SPOKE TO THE CALLER AND VICTIM SUMMER MILLER WHO STATED HER BOYFRIEND ETHAN YOUNG DID PHYSICALLY ASSAULT HER. MS. MILLER STATED THAT MR. YOUNG BECAME ANGRY WHEN SHE WAS LOOKING AT HIS PHONE AND BEGAN YELLING OBSCENE WORDS AT HER AND THREATENING HER. MS. MILLER STATED THAT WHEN SHE ATTEMPTED TO LEAVE MR. YOUNG THEN GOT IN HER CAR WITH HER IN IT AND BEGAN SLAPPING AT HER AND GRABBING HIS PHONE. MS. MILLER STATED HE STRUCK HER MULTIPLE TIMES WITH AN OPEN HAND IN THE FACE, ARMS, AND HANDS. MS. MILLER STATED THAT SHE THEN WENT INSIDE TO TELL MR. YOUNG'S MOTHER TO CALL 911 AT WHICH TIME MS. MILLER BEGAN CALLING 911. MS. MILLER STATED THAT WHILE ATTEMPTING TO CALL 911 MR. YOUNG SMACKED HER HAND CAUSING THE PHONE TO HIT MR. YOUNG'S MOTHER AND ATTEMPTED MULTIPLE TIMES TO KEEP MS. MILLER FROM CALLING 911. MS. MILLER AND MR. YOUNG ARE IN A RELATIONSHIP AND SHARE A HOUSEHOLD TOGETHER. STATEMENTS WERE TAKEN FROM MS. MILLER AS WELL AS YUVETTE YOUNG, MR. YOUNG'S MOTHER. VICTIM FORM WAS ISSUED TO MS. MILLER AND A WARRANT REQUEST WILL BE SUBMITTED FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. MR. YOUNG DID FLEE THE INCIDENT LOCATION PRIOR TO LAW ENFORCEMENTS ARRIVAL.

This letter is in reference to a incident I had with Ethan Young back in Feb of this year. I called Chester County 911 on Feb 2<sup>nd</sup> due to an incident and two officers responded (One being Officer Jon Jarvis.) I explained to him what had happened and the only things he asked me were ( my name, number, address, And if I wanted to press charges.) I told him yes that I did want to press charges. He said that the following day he would see about getting a warrant put on Ethan Young. I thought that was a little strange considering what took place (even though it was wrong) didn't really deserve as much attention as a warrant. About four days later I found out through his mother that he had been charged with a CDV 2<sup>nd</sup>. I was confused about that charge due to the fact our relationship did not fall into the scope of a CDV charge. I then made several attempts to get in contact with Officer Jon Jarvis. After about two weeks he returned my call. I inquired why he had stated on report that I shared a residence with Ethan Young. His first comment was that it "wasn't his business"

I was dating him. When I then reminded him that he had wrote that we were dating and shared a residence together in his report, he switched by saying "well, you know, you may stay the night with him sometimes." I then told Mr. Juras that I didn't appreciate him making false statements just to be able to get a warrant for Mr. Young and asked him to fix the mistake. He then said "well ma'am he did assault you." I replied I was well aware of what had taken place, but a assault charge was very different than a CDV 2nd charge. He then stated that he would contact the solicitor and see what could be done about it and get back to me. I waited a few days and called the solicitors office to see if anything had been done and was informed that no one had contacted her regarding the matter. I then contacted the next person in line being Sergeant Randy Marsh. He returned my call the day after leaving the first message and listened to my complaint and said he would look into it and get back to me. After about a week of not hearing anything, I called back and left another message. This time I recieved no call back. After one more attempt to hear from him, I

me back I decided just to go in to the Sheriff's office and speak to him face to face. I asked to speak with him and was told that he was in Rock Hill looking at cars. The lady "Lori" asked for my name and number but I asked her to just give him a call and I'd ride to meet to speak to him in Rock Hill if need be. She then walked out of the room with her cell phone, then returned quickly, telling me to just have a seat before my butt even hit the seat. Randy Marsh opened the door asking if he had an appointment with me. I told him no, but that must of been a quick trip back from Rock Hill. Didn't care for the fact of them lying to me. We walked into his office and I explained again the situation and the fact that the paperwork needed to be corrected. I let him know that without the false information that Jarvis put in the report (not only that we lived together, but also that I was hit by Mr. Young open handed in my face) that a judge would of never signed a warrant. As I got more frustrated with the situation, he just smiled and said "well he did assault you, you said that in your statement." I said to him just the same as I had said to Officer [unclear].

that yes he did assault me, but that was no reason for the facts to be stretched to get a warrant for a charge that didn't fit. He then kept just asking me if Mr. Young and myself were living together. I told him the same as I told Joras that I had two children and lived almost an hour away in Blacksburg, SC. He called Officer Joras while I was in his office and Joras stated that I told him I was staying there. I informed Randy Marsh that Ethan's mother was there the whole time and also another officer, and never was I asked if I stayed there, nor did I ever offer to make that comment. Randy Marsh said he would contact the solicitor to see what could be done. He said it was his word against mine and if I wanted to I could file a complaint against Officer Jon Joras. I said yes. I took the form and walked to the lobby to fill it out. As I was finishing it the door opened and it was Randy Marsh and he had Jon Joras beside him. I followed them into a conference room where Marsh asked Joras what I had said that made him think we shared a residence. Joras stated that I told him I was staying there.

I looked at Juras and asked "If that was the case why when you asked for my address I gave you a Blacksbury one. He just looked at me. I then asked why he felt the need to put that Ethem Young had Struck me in my face and his response was "I wrote my report off of your Statement". I then laid my statement and his report side by side on the table and asked him why they were so different then. He said nothing and my son ended the talk. He said the Chief would be contacting me. The Chief did contact me I believe the following day letting me know that it would take a few days but he wanted me to know he was looking into it. After a few days I called the Chief (Spruuss) back and was told he still hadn't talked with Juras yet. After about another week I was contacted by the Chief and was told that basically Ethem Young had other run ins with law and he did assault me, so why was it really a big deal about the charge. I was told these days an assault and a G.D.V. 2nd have about the same outcome I was outraged. I then reached out 3 different times to the Sheriff Alex Underwood. He would never return my calls. I'm not trying to not remember

Dropped. I'm trying to have them as they should be. All three of these men are trying to tell me that just because Ethan has a record that I should just let this officer get away with lying. It's not right. Never have I ever had police act this way. No one has contacted the Solicitor except for myself. I have included the report and my witness statement.

Please feel free to contact me if you need to. I have went through the right channels to resolve this matter and had to have to bother you with getting someone on the inside to take a look.
