Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, neuroendocrine tumors (NETs) often develop into cancer and, if left untreated, can result in serious illness and death; and

WHEREAS, unfortunately, NET cancer patients are often misdiagnosed or receive a delayed diagnosis, which can have a negative impact on their chance of survival and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, although there have been advances in the detection and treatment of NET cancers, not all patients are benefiting quickly enough from scientific and medical progress in the field; and

WHEREAS, timely diagnosis and proper treatment can significantly improve patient outcomes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim November 10, 2013, as

NET CANCER AWARENESS DAY

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to work together to raise awareness about NET cancer and the need for timely diagnosis and access to optimal treatment and care.
