Zoysia, Bermuda, Centipede Tips

*Chop chop, it's **time to apply pre-emergent weed control** on established warm-season lawns.*

- **Fungicide:** Zoysia, Bermuda, and Centipede lawns get an application of fungicide in October (once soil temps lower to 70 degrees) to help reduce the possibility of Large Patch. Remember, an ounce of prevention in the fall is cheaper and easier than curing Large Patch in the spring!
- **Do not aerate warm-season lawns** in fall; wait until spring.

Fall Armyworm Alert

A large number of birds in a turf area may be a sign of Fall Armyworms since they are an excellent food source for birds. Tap this button to learn how to diagnose and kill Fall Armyworms.
