

14TH ANNUAL WILD QUAIL MANAGEMENT SEMINARS

More and more farmers and other landowners are leasing their land to sportsmen and sportswomen to supplement their income. However, the bobwhite quail populations in South Carolina and the southeast have declined in the past 35-40 years due to land use changes and reduction in suitable habitat.

To instruct landowners and land managers in the proper techniques of creating habitat to support native bobwhite quail populations, the SC Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and the SC State Committee of Quail Unlimited will sponsor the 14th Annual Wild Quail Management Seminars. The two seminars will be conducted during a three-day period from March 8-10, 2001, at the Webb Wildlife Center in Hampton County.

Field demonstrations and classroom instruction will focus on habitat practices including firebreak establishment, prescribed burning, timber management, brush control, discing for natural foods and supplemental food patch plantings. Presentation will be given on wild quail natural history, biology, diseases and

IMPORTANT USDA SIGN-UP AND APPLICATION DATES

Laurie Lawson, State Executive Director of the USDA-Farm Service Agency, reminds farmers of pending application deadlines for emergency assistance programs and announces recently developed new emergency programs.

Lawson said that farmers in the state and nation are continuing to fight Mother Nature, increasing production expenses, and low commodity prices. "Through the existing programs and with the proposed new programs, USDA and FSA continue to recognize the farm community's need for support," said Lawson.

Upcoming deadlines are:

January 12, 2001

Application deadline for the 2000 Oilseeds Program. (\$500 million in payments is available to the more than 600,000 producers of the 2000 crops of eligible oilseeds including: canola, crambe, flaxseed, mustard, rapeseed, safflower, sesame, soybeans, and sunflowers.)

January 18, 2001

Sign-up begins for the 2000 Crop Disaster Program. (CDP) (Funds will be made available for producers affected by crop disaster.)

Sign-up begins for the 2000 Livestock Assistance Program (LAP). (An estimated \$438 million is available to producers for grazing losses due to weather-related disaster.)

Sign-up period begins for the 2000 Livestock Indemnity Program (LIP). (Up to \$10 million will be available to producers who lost livestock due to natural disaster, fire, and anthrax.)

Sign-up period begins for the extension of the 1999 Livestock Indemnity Program/Contract Growers (CG-LIP). (Program coverage of last year's CG-LIP will be extended through February 7, 2000.)

Late January

The four-week sign-up period for the Dairy Market Loss Assistance (DMLA III) Program. (Payments to operations that received assistance under DMLA II will be automatically issued to producers later this month. Payments will also be available to new operations and to operations that did not have 12 months of marketing established under DMLA II and will be based on October 1999-September 2000 marketing.)

February 1, 2001

Application deadline for the 2000 Crop Year Peanut Market Loss Assistance Program. (An estimated \$61 million is available to partially compensate over 16,000 producers for low commodity prices and increasing production costs.)

August 15, 2001

Application deadline for the Lamb Meat Adjustment Assistance Program. (Approximately \$10 million is available to producers whose lamb carcasses meet minimum grade specifications.)

Past President of the South Carolina Young Farmer and Agribusiness Association, he is a member of the historic Pendleton Farmers Society. Estridge is the first president of the National Young Farmer Educational Association from the south in the more than 50 year history of the organization.

Commissioner's Column

Beware of Hustlers and Rustlers

Thieves, cheats, and swindlers. They're out there, and they could be after your property.

Forestry Commission investigators say hundreds, maybe thousands, of South Carolina landowners are victims of timber crime every year.

Investigators say timber crime is rampant in the state, but nobody really knows how big the problem is. Law Enforcement Chief Mike Heath said, "We're handling 200-300 complaints a year, and I don't think we're scratching the surface." He said there are lots of ways a timber owner can become a victim. The simplest scenario is outright theft . . . somebody cuts your trees and hauls off the logs. The most likely victims are absentee landowners or landowners who seldom visit the far reaches of their timberland.

Harder to detect and much more prevalent are swindles and frauds associated with timber transactions. In these cases the landowner agrees to sell some timber, but the buyer misrepresents important information or fails to pay according to the agreement. Swindles and frauds can take many forms. One common example involves the buyer offering to cut your timber and pay you a certain amount per cord, or ton, or thousand board feet. He tells you he'll even bring you the mill receipts for every load he hauls so you can verify the payment amount. Chances are, you won't know how many loads went out, so you won't know how many receipts you should get. You're just taking the buyer's word for it. Unfortunately, not everybody is trustworthy.

Most people only sell timber once or twice in a lifetime so they can't stay current on prices, products, and procedures. Chief Heath said, "Most landowners aren't timber experts. That's what the unscrupulous buyers are counting on." He added that there some simple ways to avoid being victimized. Don't allow yourself to be pressured. Most timber situations, even the dreaded pine beetles, aren't that urgent. Get some independent professional advice on what to do and how to do it. The Forestry Commission is a good place to start, and a registered private consulting forester may eventually be required.

I am also deeply concerned over the rash of livestock thefts that have occurred and are occurring here in South Carolina and in neighboring states. According to state law, anyone convicted of the larceny of a horse, mule, cow, hog, or any other livestock in South Carolina is guilty of a felony.

The South Carolina Code of Laws (16-13-50) states that a person convicted of stealing livestock could be sentenced to a maximum of ten years or fined a maximum of \$2,500, or both, if the value of the livestock is \$5,000 or more. If the livestock is valued at less than \$5,000 and more than \$1,000, the person could be imprisoned a maximum of five years or fined a maximum of \$5,000, or both. If the livestock is valued at \$1,000 or less, the crime is considered a misdemeanor and is tried in magistrate's court.

Report timber thefts or fraud immediately to the SC Forestry Commission at 803-896-8820. And, if anyone has information on missing or stolen horses or on the whereabouts of missing or stolen equine equipment, I urge you to contact your local law enforcement officials or the South Carolina State Veterinarian's Office at (803) 788-2260.

The only "rustling" we should have in South Carolina are the pine trees swaying with the winter winds. So, beware of timber hustlers and livestock rustlers. Start the New Year with the peace of mind of having done everything possible to protect your property and the future of your loved ones.
