Subject: SCDOT Secretary Hall's Monday Storm Recovery Report

SCDOT Interim Secretary Hall's Monday storm recovery update is attached. Some of the highlights in the report are:

- State road closures are down from a peak of 541 (Oct. 5) to 125 (Oct. 26), a 77 percent decrease.
- 21 highway/bridge contractors have been engaged to assist with 62 different "emergency/spot repairs" in 13 counties.
- 35 debris collection trucks and trailers are operating.
- Debris collected to date: approx. 777 loads (38,549 cubic yards)
- SCDOT Call Center is operating 6 am—7 pm daily. There have been over 3.5 million visits to the SCDOT Road Conditions webpage during this event.
- All Interstate highways are open.
- 11 primary routes remain closed statewide.
- The majority of the current closures are on the state's Secondary System
