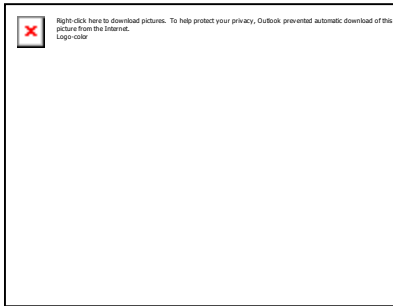
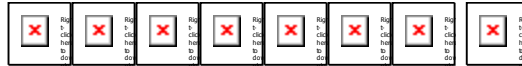

Together we will customize training for your lay members and leaders that will enable them to engage people outside of church in their own contexts.

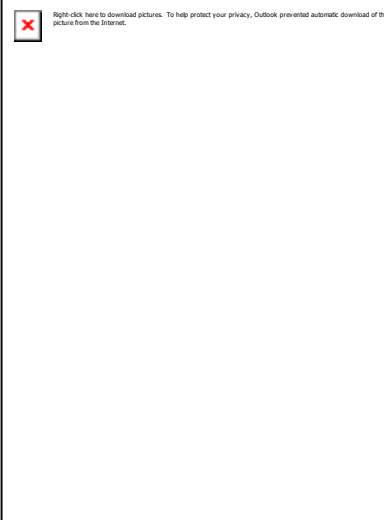

- * Customized curriculum

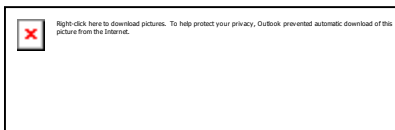

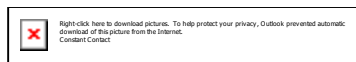
