Commissioner's Column

Be alert, not alarmed--- for West Nile and rabies viruses

Much has been said in the news lately about West Nile, a viral disease that is relatively new to South Carolina. We should be concerned, but not alarmed. There is another virus that has been around for a long time that is an immediate concern--and that's the rabies virus. We don't need to panic when we hear about these viruses, but we do need to be alert!

West Nile virus, believed to have been in the U.S. since 1999, is spread by the bite of an infected mosquito, and can infect people, horses, and several types of birds.

Most people who contract West Nile virus do not become visibly ill. Others with the virus show symptoms of fever, headache, and body aches, sometimes also with swollen lymph glands and a skin rash. On rare occasions, some with the virus will get encephalitis which causes headache, high fever, neck stiffness, confusion, coma, tremors, convulsions, paralysis, and, in some cases, death. The time between the mosquito bite and a person becoming sick is usually 5 to 15 days. There is no vaccine to prevent the disease, and there are no drugs to treat the disease in humans. There is no evidence to suggest that West Nile virus can be spread from person to person, animal to animal, or from animal to person. Symptoms of the virus in horses include listlessness, lack of coordination/stumbling, weakness in the limbs, partial paralysis, and death.

Until recently, South Carolina had no documented cases of the West Nile virus. However, a dead blue jay recently found in Lexington County that tested positive for the virus was the first confirmed evidence of the disease in the state and more have been found since that time.

We should all be aware that West Nile virus has been confirmed in South Carolina, but no one should be alarmed. We should, however, take precautions to reduce the risk of becoming infected with the West Nile virus. We should stay indoors at dawn, dusk, and in the early evening; wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants, if we must be outdoors at these times; make sure the screens on windows and doors are in good repair; apply insect repellent with the ingredient DEET sparingly to exposed skin; and make sure that there is no standing water in bird baths and open containers around the house.

Each of us can play an important role in monitoring West Nile virus. Report dead blue jays, crows, or raptors (owls, hawks, or eagles) to your local health department. If you find a dead bird, put an inverted zip lock bag over your hand, pick up the bird and flip the bag back to the right side, and seal. Keep on ice and deliver to the nearest local health department.

Aside from West Nile, the other virus of which we should be aware is rabies, a viral disease affecting the central nervous system transmitted from infected warm-blooded mammals. Rabies is a threat to domestic and wild animals as well as to humans. The word "rabies" comes from a Latin word that means, "to rage." Animals with rabies often act as if they are angry.

Rabies is contracted from the saliva of a rabid animal, usually from a bite. Rabies targets the body's nervous system, causing encephalitis and ultimately death. As the disease progresses, symptoms appear including insomnia, anxiety, confusion, slight or partial paralysis, excitation, hallucinations, agitation, hypersalivation, difficulty swallowing, and hydrophobia (fear of water). Exposure of man to a rabid animal does not always result in rabies. If preventive treatment is obtained promptly following a rabies exposure, most cases of rabies will be prevented. Untreated cases will invariably result in death.

In 2001, there were 143 cases of rabies confirmed in animals in South Carolina. Positive rabies cases last year included 80 raccoons, 25 skunks, 25 foxes, four bats, four cats, four dogs, and one horse. Domestic animals--particularly cats, cattle, dogs, and horses--are susceptible to the rabies virus.

Rabies is preventable. South Carolina law requires every pet cat and dog to be vaccinated against rabies by a licensed veterinarian. The owner of an unvaccinated cat or dog may be found guilty of a misdemeanor and fined up to \$100 or imprisoned up to 30 days. We require a copy of a current Rabies Vaccination Certificate signed by a veterinarian to accompany each dog ad for the Market Bulletin to help in the effort to eradicate rabies.

Each of us can also play a role in rabies prevention. Have all your pets---cats, dogs, and horses---vaccinated. Avoid wild animals at all costs. Use caution when dealing with any pet that may have been harmed by a suspicious animal. Get help immediately if you or your pets have been bitten by any animal and notify your local vector control officials.

Both West Nile and rabies could be terrifying viruses with horrifying outcomes, but because of the effort underway to protect the citizens of the state, there is no need to panic. We need to do all that we can do to prevent contracting these diseases. We need to stay alert---not alarmed!
