SECTION 5: The Honorable W. Brantley Harvey, Jr. of Beaufort, having qualified on March 13, 1990 as Commissioner for the fourteenth Highway District, composed of Beaufort, Hampton, Allendale, Jasper and Colleton Counties, took his seat as a member of the Commission.

SECTION 6: The Honorable Richard B. Ness of Bamberg, having qualified on April 19, 1990 as Commissioner for the second Highway District, composed of Bamberg, Aiken, and Barnwell Counties, took his seat as a member of the Commission.

SECTION 7: The Minutes of the meeting of March 15, 1990; copies of which have been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting monthly reports as published by the Department of activities for month of March, 1990.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase orders issued for amounts in excess of \$1,000.00 during the month of March, 1990, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into a supplemental agreement with Stevens and Wilkinson, Inc. for additional design services for a new weigh-in-motion scale in Greenville and Spartanburg counties at an estimated cost of \$110,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 11: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into a supplemental agreement with Michael Baker, Jr., Inc. for additional design services for the replacement of the Battery Creek Bridge in Beaufort county at an estimated cost of \$250,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 12: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into a supplemental agreement with Wilbur Smith Associates for engineering studies concerning hazardous wastes studies on U. S. Route 52 in Berkeley and Williamsburg counties at an estimated cost of \$33,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 13: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into a supplemental agreement with Michael Baker, Jr., Inc. to provide additional engineering services for the Battery Creek bridge replacement in Beaufort county at an approximate cost of \$450,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 14: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into a supplemental agreement with Ralph Whitehead and Associates to provide additional engineering services for the Dawhoo River bridge replacement in Charleston county at an approximate cost of \$550,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 15: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into a supplemental agreement with Campco Engineering, Inc. for additional engineering services for a feasibility study of the Anderson Bypass/Connector in Anderson and Abbeville counties at an estimated cost of \$215,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 16: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into a contract with a consultant engineering diving service for underwater bridge inspection in various counties at a cost of \$150,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 17: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into an agreement with the United States Geological Survey to perform site inspections of 7800 bridges which cross water to determine the potential for scour at a cost of \$375,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 18: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Clemson University to inventory pre-1951 highway bridges to determine which structures are potentially of national historic significance at a cost of \$85,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 19: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into a contract with Brockington and Associates, Inc. to mitigate an archaeological site adjacent to the Mark Clark Expressway in the amount of \$73,593.76, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 20: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing an additional appropriation of \$2,815,415 for highway maintenance, as shown in the Appendix.

This will enable the Department to remain in compliance with FHWA and AASHTO regulations which require bridges that meet certain criteria receive underwater inspections on a regular cycle not to exceed five years.

It is recommended that the Commission approve of the Department entering into this contract. The estimated cost of performing this work is \$150,000.00.

CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

BRIDGE SCOUR EVALUATIONS

The Department has entered into an agreement with the United State Geological Survey (USGS) to perform site inspections of approximately 7800 bridges which cross water to determine the potential for scour. Phase I which consist of approximately 3500 bridges began April 3, 1990 and is to be completed by March 30, 1991. The estimated cost of Phase I is approximately \$375,000.00. The Commission will be notified prior to the beginning of Phase II which will include the remaining bridges and any additional detailed analyzes required by the Department. The estimated cost of Phase II is approximately \$250,000.00. The hydraulic engineering services were required by the FHWA to remain in compliance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards (NBIS).

This agreement was executed prior to formal Commission approval because of the strict time frame recently imposed by the FHWA on state highway departments nationwide.

Agreement for Engineering Consultant Services

The Department requests Commission approval to enter into an agreement with Clemson University to inventory pre-1951 highway bridges to determine which structures are potentially of national historic significance. Approximately 200 of a total of 1100 structures have been identified for the study as a result of a pilot study concluded last year by Clemson personnel. Cost of this study will be \$85,000 with funding to be programmed under Rural Secondary.

The study is required under Section 126(f) of the Surface Transportation and Uniform Relocation Assistance Act of 1987.

CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

Pursuant to the Commission's previous action of September 21, 1989 authorizing the Department to seek Consultant Services to mitigate an archaeological site adjacent to the Mark Clark Expressway near the Wando River in Charleston County. The Department has entered into a contract with Brockington and Associates, Inc., in the amount of \$73,593.76. Work is to be funded under the Federal Aid Program.

Recommendations - 4/19/90

APPROPRIATION - HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE

It is requested that the Commission authorize an additional appropriation of \$2,815,415 for highway maintenance. Unanticipated extraordinary maintenance projects as a result of Hurricane Hugo have been allotted in this amount.
