Amber,

Thank you again for sharing a copy of the waiver with us, and for getting it submitted, but I did want some clarification on one point. In “8. Justification for request,” you write “South Carolina is requesting a modification and extension of its existing waiver to exempt residents residing in the entire State from the work requirements of 7 CFR 273.24 *due to having insufficient jobs* based on the U.S. Department of Labor data that the State qualifies for extended unemployment benefits.” (emphasis added). But, we are not requesting the extension due to having insufficient jobs. We are requesting the waiver for the reasons you highlight in “9. Anticipated impact on households and State agency operations.” That is, extra time for our agencies to have ABAWD time tracking infrastructure completed, and DEW take over management of E&T.

Is that language that must be included in these waiver submissions, because you cannot get the waiver without saying what the waiver qualifications are? I just want to make sure we are all on the same page for the reason we requested the waiver, and the goals we are trying to accomplish, without bringing any unnecessary scrutiny on our agencies. Please feel free to call if it is easier.
