- WHEREAS,** Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists (CRNAs) are essential to America's healthcare system, providing high-quality, cost-effective anesthesia care for more than 125 years; and
- WHEREAS,** CRNAs are anesthesia specialists who are the hands-on dispensers of approximately 30 million anesthetics given to patients in the United States each year; and
- WHEREAS,** CRNAs are the sole anesthesia providers in more than two-thirds of all rural hospitals, affording these medical facilities obstetrical, surgical, and trauma stabilization capabilities; and
- WHEREAS,** CRNAs practice in a variety of settings including traditional hospital surgical suites and obstetrical delivery rooms, ambulatory surgical centers, offices of dentists, podiatrists, ophthalmologists, and plastic surgeons, and military, public health service, and veterans' medical facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim January 20 - 26, 2013, as
