Farmers get crop disaster help

Farmers who have suffered severe crop damage may now sign up for cash grants if they have lost at least 35 percent of their 1999 crops because of natural disasters.

The national 2000 agriculture appropriations act provided \$1.2 billion for the Crop Disaster Program. Eligible farmers will receive an advance payment equal to 35 percent of their projected total payment after all applications have been received and approved.

For more information, farmers can contact their local Farm Service Agency office, usually listed in telephone directories under U.S. Government, Department of Agriculture.

Commissioner's Column

A helping hand for the holidays

This may be hard to believe, but you wouldn't be holding this issue of the Market Bulletin—the last issue of the 1900s—if it weren't for a local man who made sure no one's holiday was spoiled by the closing of a small printing company.

Carolina Printing Center, located in Cayce, has printed, sorted and mailed the Market Bulletin for more than 20 years. But when we received a letter this month announcing that the printing center was closing—effective immediately—we worried whether this issue would make it to our subscribers.

But our troubles were nothing compared to those of the 12 employees at Carolina Printing who had no idea when they arrived to work one day that they wouldn't be returning the next.

So Carolina Printing's former manager, Jack Decker, stepped up to the plate to lend a very big hand.

He found job offers for each employee who was laid off when the center closed—within 48 hours of their dismissals. I'm not sure Santa himself could have pulled that off so smoothly.

So what was Jack's interest in helping all these people? He has worked off and on with Carolina Printing for 25 years, as its manager as well as in other capacities. Over the years, Jack made many personal friendships with CPC's employees and clients. When he heard the company suddenly closed, he felt he needed to help. Jack said he couldn't bear to think of his long-time friends suddenly being laid-off from their jobs, especially at Christmas time.

Once CPC's clients found out the company had closed, Jack scrambled to find companies to print their publications. The job was nothing out of the ordinary for him; as a professional printing broker, it's his job to match printers with clients. But he worked beyond the call of duty after CPC closed. His phone and cell phone were ringing off their hooks with calls from former CPC clients and their prospective printing companies.

Trust me, it's no small feat to find a company that can print, sort and mail almost 60,000 Market Bulletins. But because of Jack's efforts, the Market Bulletin has continued uninterrupted as it has since 1913, except for a brief period during the Great Depression. For all these years, the Bulletin has helped farmers and nonfarmers to sell and buy farm products, which helps the entire agricultural community. The Bulletin meets many farmers' needs, needs that no generalized publication would be able to meet. Where else can you find a complete listing of used tractors, farm equipment and most other farm needs or such a large variety of plants and flowers for gardeners? And, the Department of Agriculture further supports soybean farmers by printing each Market Bulletin in soybean ink. The Bulletin reaches slightly fewer than 60,000 S.C. households twice a month, and it averages 800 ads per issue—that's more than 19,000 ads a year.

Although I'm personally glad the Market Bulletin will continue to be published as usual, what I'm most relieved about is that all the employees who were laid off now have jobs or job prospects. All because one man wanted to help them. Jack could simply have found new printing companies for CPC's clients and profited from his findings, but his concern for others wouldn't let him stop there.

My staff at the SCDA and I wish you all a joyous holiday season. And I wish you all a very happy New Year as we enter the year 2000.
