## Governor's Proclamation

**WHEREAS,** osteogenesis imperfecta (OI), also known as "brittle bone disease," is a genetic disorder characterized by fragile bones that break easily; and

**WHEREAS,** there are different types of OI with a range of severity from mild to life threatening; and

**WHEREAS,** as there is no cure for OI, treatment focuses on minimizing fractures, the surgical correction of deformity, reducing bone fragility, and maximizing mobility and independent function; and

**WHEREAS,** Osteogenesis Imperfecta Awareness Week helps raise awareness of OI and the need for education and research to help find more effective treatments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 3 - 10, 2014, as**

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to learn more about OI and to work together to help bring about acceptance and support for those with this disorder.
