The Commission approved an application from Mr. W. C. McCall, Associate Professor at the University of S. C., to perform part-time services for the Department of Education at additional compensation of \$500.00 per year.

The Commission approved the employment by the Insurance Commissioner of Rhey W. Harrington, at a salary of \$150.00 per month, and declined to approve the employment of Mr. L. George Benjamin, Jr., as Inspector, at a salary of \$150.00 per month.

The Commission declined to pay the costs of the Supreme Court hearing in Scroggie vs. Bates, amounting to \$146.00, submitted by A. W. Holman, attorney for Scroggie.

The Commission then adjourned.

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
