I recently received a letter, dated Oct. 17, that North Charleston Mayor Keith Summey sent to Gov. Haley earlier this month and have attached it for reference.

My question is whether Gov. Haley has any plans to "spur the SCSPA and SCDOT into action," as the mayor requested, to deal with the promised construction of overpasses related to an intermodal rail facility serving the Leatherman terminal. If so, what are those plans?
