
**Chairman Wright asked Bill Clark, County Administrator, to give an overview of the matter before County Council. Mr. Clark stated the ordinance is**


Motion by Councilwoman Cooper, seconded by Councilman Wimberly, to give third and final reading to the ordinance. Motion passed unanimously with no opposition.

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
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
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
