All – Per Greg Fluke (SCDEW), who confirmed with Denis Udwin (one of the owners), the company is closed.

Attached is our long history with them.

They filed for bankruptcy late last year and we offered to assist them one last time after we received notification. According to Greg, Mr. Udwin said that they have been purchased by Imperial Toys, a Mexican company and likely a Walmart supplier, too. They will move operations to Tijuana.

Randy Clack, plant manager, told Greg that most of the 130 employees had been gradually let go “for cause” and the rest will be laid off.

Greg is meeting with Randy tomorrow and will provide any updates. The company will likely file a Trade petition.
