

My name is Lakeitha Jackson and I am writing on behalf of my husband Cornelius Jackson. We are residents of Georgia. My husband is currently incarcerated in Berkeley County, South Carolina. He is being held for a civil case of a child support violation. My husband is very sick; he has been diagnosed with torn rotator cuff, which causes daily pain, prostate disease and high blood pressure. The Berkeley county jail is currently denying his proper medical treatment and medications. My husband was actively obtaining treatment from the VA hospital prior to his incarceration. I have spoken with the Veterans Administration (VA hospital) and they are willing to service him if I bring him in for treatment, however the VA has informed me that they will not interfere with Berkley county decisions. At this time I am not financially able to afford an attorney, I am writing today to see if there is any way that you can help me get my husband a pardon so that he may get the medical care that he needs at the VA hospital. My husband is a disabled veteran who has served this country as well as the Desert Storm War.
