**Evolution: Declaring War on Fossil Fuels**

**One of the saddest tragedies I witnessed during the #Occupy movements was the lack of defined goals and measured success. Too many mixed messages, too many problems. Not because anyone was dumb or confused. The public was and still is frustrated, fed up, and looking for 'change'. What was lacking was a**

conduit for the concerted effort, and a conduit that would not hurt the already bankrupt cities hosting the event. The stores, and ports are staffed by the blue collared worker you are fighting for. One should not make their life harder to be heard. Think of the businesses you are blocking, the people just trying to get to work, the people trying to make a living. More than resentment, the efforts are creating division among the public.

It is easy for anyone to point at what is wrong. What resonated with me was the amount of problems and issues that the #occupy movement were protesting, were issues we could solve ourselves. Government, pollution, the economy. They are all attributed to the source of money causing the corruption, climate change, and jobs being lost. The source is fossil fuels, and petrochemicals. The money funds campaigns, and their agendas. Their agenda and ours as a public are fundamentally different.

### **On with the War.**

When military strategy is applied to business practice, the truth becomes increasingly clear as you will see here. All that has happened and continues to happen is simply the death throes of industries delaying the inevitable downfall by any and all assets they possess. Protection of market share and methods on which to feed it results in the profits to extend solvency.

In laymen's terms, businesses that would not exist today left to their own means to sell a product for a higher price than which they acquire it. They need help, and lots of it in terms of favorable legislation, no corporate taxes, and subsidies with the backing of a powerful military to maintain their power. Money flows in every direction. However, one main factor exists. It starts with each of us globally. Every time we make a purchase, we alone sustain unsustainable cycles resulting in our own mass suicide. You have numerous methods in which to choose your demise but equally limited to the resource in which they originate. Pollution, hunger, draught, modern cancers, war, and even the food you eat has been infected with the poison.

### **Declaring "War" on Fossil Fuels.**

Let's declare a War on Fossil Fuels. The true "Axis of Evil" is Oil, Coal, and Natural Gas. Our objective is to stop fossil fuels ability to harm us. In order to stop fossil fuels, we must stop the demand and the money that brings it out of the ground.

Our biggest weapons are the money we use to make purchases and the development of other resources to replace what fossil fuel provides.

### **Creating a Strategy.**

"Peak Oil" has brought the issue of oil to the forefront. The doomsday fanatics have highlighted oil playing a part in not only energy, but in everything we buy. The "Crude Awakening" film told us to get ready for a life without oil, and an existence similar to life in the 1700's.

### **WRONG.**

Fossil fuels being attributed to consumer products actually provides the public opportunities to participate in this war. If you look at how the demand for coal and oil grew, it becomes evident the strategy works or we wouldn't be in this mess, and the strategy should be adopted by competing resources like bamboo and hemp.

What began as products of energy, heat, and building materials were now hopelessly locked into every industry internationally at the same time humans were beginning to interact on an international scale through travel and media.

International trade opened up new markets, while Americans were establishing a middle class the world was trying to emulate. Conspicuous consumption and consumerism were creating a demand for additional petrochemicals and materials derived from fossil fuels. The same fossil fuels that were beginning to gain the public's attention as the source of the leading health and environmental issues.

We established and epitomized our addictions in much the same way a drug addict has every fact available to him that his habit is life threatening, yet he still buys more. Driven by the need for profit and growth, industry provided the vices on an international scale.

Opinions vary from sinister plots to take over the world to the devil's own hand in the creation of our fossil fuel driven economies. The host as well as the cure remains money. The symptoms and treatments became an issue of lowering costs while increasing sales resulting in the desired effect: Profit.

The development of solar panels, wind turbines, and other methods of capturing abundant sources of energy negates the need for biofuels on a mass scale as

energy. Our efforts need to stay focused on developing material and chemicals; not energy. The linear nature of liquid fuels, excludes the use of bioresources on mass scale. We have natural replacements for energy to burn. We need to develop the sustainable materials to build the solar panels and wind turbines to capture the energy, and take fossil fuels out of the equation.

On average, 1 MW of wind capacity requires 103 tons of stainless steel, 402 tons of concrete, 6.8 tons of fiberglass, 3 tons of copper and 20 tons of cast iron. That is a lot of fossil fuels. The elegant blades are made of fiberglass, the skyscraper sized tower of steel, and the base of concrete. That is a very large upfront investment and profit center for Fossil fuel Industries. One that is out of reach of the average consumer without federal subsidies and other cash incentives. Maintenance and service life may also be a concern. Because the technology is emerging, as in the case of fossil fuels, the true cost is not evident during industry creation.

That is a lot of fossil fuels but they can be replaced. In China turbine blades are being constructed of bamboo. Hemp concrete exists, and the tower could be made of bamboo. A renewable energy source made with renewable materials.

There has been a "superconductor" material made of Hemp, and bamboo was used as Thomas Edison's first light bulbs as the filament. It is foreseeable these two sources could be used to create solar panels. The savings in materials and transportation costs will make the technology more widely spread and available.

The use of bamboo and hemp in renewable energy generation is the end goal. Development of materials for everyday products sold in Walmart or Target is the way.

Our strategy is born. The focus must be on materials and chemicals to compete with fossil fuels in everyday products. Our success measured in dollars denied to fossil fuels and petrochemicals. Our mission is to provide products made of hemp and bamboo for a lower price than the fossil fuel version on Target's and Walmart's shelf.

The evolution occurs when the public buys hemp and bamboo products based on price not pollution. You do not need to convince someone to save money. Therefore, the same demand will be created just as it was for fossil fuel products.
