A INFORMAL MEETING OF THE ANDERSON COUNTY COUNCIL WAS HELD IN THE OFFICE OF THE SUPERVISOR, JANUARY 13, 1977, AT 7:00 P.M.

MR. DAVID HOOPER OPENED THE MEETING WITH PRAYER.

MR. ROY COFFEE OF THE ANDERSON ARTS COUNCIL ASKED FOR CONTINUATION SUPPORT OF THE FIVE THOUSAND(\$5,000.00) IN THE BUDGET FOR 1977-78 FISCAL YEAR AND TO FULFILL A PRIOR COMMITMENT TO PAVE THE PARKING LOT BEHIND THE ARTS CENTER, 405 NORTH MAIN STREET, ANDERSON, S. C.

MRS. SARA LIVERANCE APPEARED WITH MR. COFFEE AND GAVE A BRIEF REPORT OF THE FUNCTIONS OF THE ARTS CENTER.

MR. BOB LOYD OF APPALACHIAN COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENT GAVE A BRIEF RESUME TO THE COUNCIL OF ITS OPERATIONS AND SUGGESTED THAT TWO REPRESENTATIVES BE APPOINTED FROM THE COUNTY COUNCIL TO REPRESENT THE COUNTY. THE COUNCIL APPROVED MR. BOB LOYDS REQUEST FOR CONTINUATION OF THE STUDIES OF THE OVERALL MANAGER REVIEW, OPERATION FOR STOCKADE, PERSONNEL, DEVELOPMENT OF PURCHASING PROCEDURES AND ETC., UNTIL TOLD TO STOP.

MR. DAVID WILLIFORD DISCUSSED THE NEW SOUTH EDITION. WANTED THE COUNTY TO PUT TOGETHER A ADVERTISEMENT IN THE ADDITION TO COME ON JANUARY 30, 1977. MR. POORE WILL CONTACT AT A LATER DATE.

MR. THOMAS GABLE AND MR. JAMES TATE DISCUSSED THE ROBERT MATTISON ROAD. THEY HAVE A BAD PROBLEM WITH THEIR ROAD. THIS PART IS NOT IN THE COUNTY SYSTEM. MR. POORE WILL HAVE MAC WALTERS, COUNTY ENGINEER TO CHECK INTO THIS AND SEE WHAT COULD BE DONE TO HELP.

THE COUNCIL RECEIVED THE 1975-1976 FISCAL YEAR AUDIT FROM MR. MARCHANT LESLEY, THE COUNTY AUDITOR. HE DISCUSSED THE MANAGEMENT LETTER. MR. LESLEY SAID THERE WAS STILL SOME CHANGES THAT COULD BE MADE TO REDUCE PAPER WORK WHILE PUTTING TIGHTER REINS ON THE CASH FLOW IN AND OUT OF SOME OFFICES. GENERALLY, HOWEVER, THE AUDITOR PRAISED COUNTY OFFICES FOR THEIR EFFORTS "TO COMPLY WITH GOOD INTERNAL CONTROL REQUIREMENTS AND FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT".

MR. LESLEY IS TO MEET AT A LATER DATE WITH THE COUNCIL TO DISCUSS THE AUDIT IN ITS ENTIRETY.


