Dear Mr. Augustine:

The Application submitted by Charles A. Miller, for Notary Public renewal raises questions about the authenticity of the document and the information it conveys. The mailing addresses and telephone number submitted Mr. Charles A. Miller, connects to Deborah M. Smalls, Administrator, Waterfront Employers - I.L.A Pension and Welfare Fund, South Carolina Area.

If the application is "Certified to be a true and correct copy as taken from and compared with the original on file in this office", does that means it is an exact duplicate of the original on file, except for the redacted portion?

There are **required** elements of notarial acts under South Carolina law, which is absent from the application..."The legible appearance of the notary's name exactly as shown on the notary's commission. This can be the notary's typed or printed name near his or her signature or can be ascertained from somewhere in the notarial certificate or from the notary's seal, if legible." Because these elements of the notarial act are missing from the application, are you concern about its authenticity?

The bottom portion of the application, to be completed by Charleston County Legislative Delegation, is also void of required documentation. The names listed in option (3), may or may not be the names of the present (2012) **Charleston County** legislative delegates because that part of the application is blank. In spite of that, the names listed in option (3), suggests that the legislative delegation has determined to endorse notaries public by the signatures of at least half of the present legislative delegates from the county in which the applicant resides. That means that each of the signatures must be specific to each delegate.

Your statement, "Members of the delegation may all select the same person or persons to endorse application on their behalf" is simply verbal gymnastics. To be precise - "a legislator may provide for the endorsement of these applications by authorizing either the member serving as chairman or the member serving as secretary of the legislative delegation of the county in which the applicant resides to sign on the legislator's behalf." Option (1) would then be the appropriate choice. You may want to consult your files to determine the endorsement method/s adopted by the Charleston County Legislative Delegation.

Whether or not there is fraud associated with this application can best be answered by the Office of the Secretary of State. Does Charles A. Miller exist in fact, or is Charles A. Miller, an identity fabricated out of whole cloth? A notary search on the Secretary of State web page for Charles A, Miller, Charleston County, produces the result - "No Search Results were found". However, if you search "Charles Miller", up pops the name "Miller, Charles A". Why is that?

If the application itself does not contain the required elements that constitute a notarial act, on what basis was this commission granted. What information can you glean from the supposedly Notary Seal on Charles A. Miller's application?

What say you?
