

RESOLUTION OF THE  
SOUTH CAROLINA COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION

WHEREAS, Major General James A. Grimsley, Jr., USA, Retired, has served with distinction as President of The Citadel from 1980 until 1989; and

WHEREAS, for four years prior to being named president he served that institution as Vice-President for Business and Finance; and

WHEREAS, throughout his entire thirteen year tenure with The Citadel, he reflected the views of that institution before the Commission and its committees with great dignity and tact; and

WHEREAS, his statements were thoughtful and articulate, his positions prudent and precise, and his advice logical and temperate; and

WHEREAS, he demonstrated by his statements and actions a deep concern for students, faculty, and staff, and for a proper balance between institutional autonomy and state level coordination; and

WHEREAS, he has informed the Board of Visitors of The Citadel of his retirement, effective 30 June 1989;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Commission on Higher Education expresses its sincere appreciation to him for his dedicated service to higher education in South Carolina, and wishes him, in this second retirement, continued vigor and great happiness.
