Main section of the house has a rectangular plan and a cross-gabled roof; side-gabled roof dominates the front elevation, with front facing gable over the southern bay. Shed-roofed addition has been appended to the south elevation. Door centered beneath front gable has classic surround; six-over-six, wooden sash window on either side. Side gabled portion has three single six-over-six, wooden sash windows. Full-width, hipped porch supported by Tuscan columns.
