Description/Significant Features:

The front elevation has a full-width, hipped-roofed porch that is supported by square columns that rest on stone piers. Three-bay front façade has a central door with a single one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl window to the west and a paired one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl window to the east. Three bays deep, with a paired one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl window flanked by a single, one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl window on either side. Front elevation has a large, gabled dormer centered with two, tall, two-pane horizontal sliding windows within it; symmetrical, smaller gabled dormers are located centered in the side elevations. Interior brick chimney.
