> The letter outlines steps we are taking in all 54 National Guards to help National Guard Bureau avoid an Anti-Deficiency Act Violation based on a National shortfall of about \$70 M on the Army National Guard side. We are all concerned about why we are finding out about the shortage during the last month of the year but we are working as a team to solve the issue. South Carolina, as well as most of the states, has managed its budget appropriately. This reprogramming is causing us to move drills to the end of the month or early next month. There will be some impact to the Soldiers but we will make it as minimal as possible. This action should not affect our readiness.
