I have been a business man in Miramar Florida, for over 30 years, exporting medical supplies and equipment, served on several Florida Chambers Of Commerce committee, travel to many countries with Enter - Prize Florida and former Governor Jeb Bush promoting Florida export business, and also has been invited several times to travel international with Florida current governor Rick Scott.

The family of Mr. Cecil Simmons informed me of his incarceration in your State for over 24 years, I also spoke with Cecil Simmons on four occasions and promised him I will write to you on his behalf. Based on what I was told, it seems to me, Mr. Simmons punishment exceeds the crime he was charge with. I am appealing to you on behalf of his family to re-visit Cecil Simmons case. Perhaps the woman involve may speak the truth at this time.


Mr. Cecil Simmons is a citizen of the Turks and Caicos Islands, with no legal status in the USA, came into the USA on a Visa Waiver, (Turks and Caicos Islands Citizen do not require a visa to enter the USA) he has no formal education, cannot adequately explain himself in court, had no money for good legal defense and was given a life sentence for sexual assault, on a woman whom he met and was out partying and drinking with most of the night.

I can attest that you demonstrated your character, strength, courage and humanity after the shooting of Senator Clementi Pinkney, and the removal of the Confederate Flag demonstrated, your authentic leadership and capability for helping others.

I would like for you to release Mr. Simmons to his family in Florida, deport him to The Turks and Caicos Island based on the time already served or send him to the Turks and Caicos Island to serve the rest of his time in their prison.

I sincerely hope that you will find it within your heart to demonstrate compassion on Mr. Simmons during the Christmas Seasons.
