Good Afternoon Katherine,

Pursuant to our discussion yesterday, please find below a few thoughts on areas of co-operation :

South Carolina to Punjab

Skill development: Sharing of best practices and helping establish a program on the pattern of ReadySC, ReadyPUNJAB. (Close to the heart of the CM)

Promote co-operation in areas of Tourism and help Punjab develop itself as a tourism destination

Aerospace: the Indian Aerospace industry will witness a rapid growth requiring Global OEM's to establish major manufacturing presence in India. South Carolina could help Punjab in developing this sector by sharing best practices and as the supply chain in SC needs to expand in India, Punjab could be promoted as a destination.

Punjab to South Carolina

Pharmaceuticals : Punjab is home to some of the largest Indian pharma talent pool, we could promote and help establish Pharmaceuticals (generic) manufacturing in South Carolina. As an input, we would need a probable list of medicines of interest and a few customers references. (I would personally interested in establishing a base for this , worked on this for a few years)

Education : in the fields of engineering and other similar areas, tie ups can be established with institutes

Investment Destination: Punjab will promote SC as a destination for businesses looking to expand in the US, from Manufacturing to services to distribution

These are just a few thoughts which could be refined after discussions, with a refined outline and a draft, we could establish a Joint Working group with key officials, businesses and institutes to formalize the relationship by the way of an agreement between the leadership of both the sates.
