> I sent you an informal email yesterday but wanted to follow with more official questions today. I am working on a deadline at 2 pm today and any information, as always, will be greatly appreciated.

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> 1. Does Governor Haley have a general reaction to the additional plutonium being brought into the state despite her official objections in the letter to Secretary Moniz asking him to divert the shipment?

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> 2. Did the DOE notify the Governor's office of the incoming shipment as it arrived or before its being unloaded in South Carolina?

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> 3. Will this impact the state's approach to the MOX lawsuit?

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> 4. Does the Governor feel like the state has the power to negotiate with the DOE or federal government for its well-being?

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> 5. Will the state take any action to try and speed up processing and/or removal of this and other radioactive material from the state?
