February 15, 2007

The regular monthly meeting of the Department of Transportation Commission was held at the headquarters building in Columbia, South Carolina at 1:30 p.m. In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, the news media was advised in writing of the time, date and place of this meeting.

SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of January 18, 2007; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving an amendment to the 2007 STIP, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to advertise, select and negotiate with consulting firms to provide cultural resource services on an "on-call" basis, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Clarendon County Transportation Committee to self administer "C" funds, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending existing bituminous contracts to include additional resurfacing work, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending existing construction contracts to include additional work, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department related to roads in the State Highway Secondary System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department concerning projects in the highway letting of January 9, 2007, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: Commissioner Jones reported for the Invitations and Resolutions Committee and made a motion requesting Commission approval of the following resolutions:

- Dwight O'Neal "Buddy" Gilstrap Bridge – Pickens County
- Clifton Randall "Randy" Jones Bridge – Pickens County
- Dr. James E. Leppard, Jr. Bridge – Town of Cheraw
- James D. Batchler Bridge – Cherokee County
- James Thomas "Tom" Teal Road – Chesterfield County

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Stevenson and passed unanimously by the Commission. Copies of the adopted resolutions are shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: Commissioner Carnell reported for the Legislative Committee. The committee received a report on pending legislation in the House and Senate and also received an update on the Federal Corridors of the Future Program application process. Since this application will possibly involve the tolling of an existing interstate, it was the feeling of the legislative committee that the Commission should update the legislative leadership and seek support for the application. No motions were presented.

SECTION 11: Commissioner Stevenson reported for the Mass Transit Committee and presented the following motion for approval:

1. Approve allocation in the amount of \$127,258 provided to Newberry County Council on Aging for continued operation of the Newberry SmartRide project through June 30, 2007.
2. Approve allocation in the amount of \$8,442 provided to Santee Wateree Regional Transportation Authority for continued operation of the Camden Lugoff SmartRide project through June 30, 2007.
3. Carryover funds in the amount of \$244,300 to be utilized in FY 2007-2008 in support of current SmartRide program and anticipated expanded service.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Carnell and approved unanimously by the Commission.

Commissioner Stevenson made a motion requesting Commission approval to fund the Lower Savannah Council of Governments \$50,000 to engage a consultant to conduct a public transportation feasibility study in the Orangeburg/Calhoun area. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Atkins and passed unanimously by the Commission.

Commissioner Stevenson made a motion requesting Commission approval of the committees' recommendation on a funding request by the City of Seneca. The recommendation is to provide \$107,954 in funding in lieu of 2008 funding. The Executive Director will work with the Mass Transit staff on this recommendation and the action will not be implemented unless approved by the Executive Director. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Jones and passed unanimously by the Commission.

SECTION 12: Chairman Hooper reported for the Finance Committee. The committee received a report on the disrepair of rest areas and welcome centers in the state and discussed ways to fund the needed repairs. Chairman Hooper stated that the committee received a presentation on various conferences the Department participates in. The committee also discussed the State of the DOT finances and a request to approve the 2007 Comprehensive Permanent Improvement Plan (CPIP).

SECTION 13: On motion of Commissioner Jones, seconded by Commissioner Atkins, the Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the 2007 Comprehensive Permanent Improvement Plan (CPIP) and authorizing the Department to forward the CPIP to the Office of State Budget, South Carolina Budget and Control Board. The motion further approved CPIP year one projects funding using the state highway fund and requesting funding for years two through five projects from the State Capital Improvements bonds during the normal state budget cycle. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Atkins and passed unanimously.

SECTION 14: On motion of Commissioner Atkins, seconded by Commissioner Stevenson, the Commission unanimously passed a motion amending the Commission Bylaws to provide that the Director of Audits report to, be hired, terminated and evaluated by the Commission in coordination with the Director of Human Resources. A copy of the amendment to the bylaws is shown detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 15: Chairman Hooper appointed Commissioners Carnell and Stevenson to serve as members of the Audit Committee. Chairman Hooper will serve as Chairman of the committee.

SECTION 16: On motion of Commissioner Carnell, seconded by Commissioner Stevenson, the Commission unanimously passed a motion to go in to Executive Session.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Commission went into Executive Session at 4:10 p.m. for the purpose of discussing legal matters.

OPEN SESSION

The Commission returned to Open Session at 4:40 p.m. Chairman Hooper reported that no action was taken.

SECTION 17: There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 4:42 p.m.

Professional Services Recommendations

February 15, 2007

The following sheets include recommendations for the Department to utilize professional consulting firms to provide various services, which may include design, right of way acquisitions, construction engineering and inspection, or other associated services. The Department requests approval from the Commission to advertise, select and negotiate for these necessary services.

REQUEST FOR CONSULTANTS TO PERFORM "ON-CALL" CULTURAL RESOURCE SERVICES

The Department requests Commission approval to advertise, select and negotiate with consulting firms to provide cultural resource services (archaeology and architectural history) on an "on-call" basis. The purpose of having "on-call" consultants is to provide additional cultural resource services when the Department's staff is not able to perform the required studies in a timely manner. The Department's archaeological staff is currently the equivalent of one full-time position (two persons, with each performing approximately 50% NEPA compliance and 50% cultural resources compliance). An additional purpose of having "on-call" consultants is to expedite project development by performing cultural resource studies immediately upon receipt of survey data (electronic survey file). Initiating cultural resource studies at this point during the project development process increases the Department's workload (up to 3 times) but ultimately eliminates (or minimizes) schedule delays and redesign due to cultural resources.

The Department will select three (3) consulting firms for "on-call" services through a Quality Based Selection process that emphasizes the following criteria: experience, qualifications, past performance, and expertise. For each project (i.e. each particular scope of services), the Department and the consulting firm will independently prepare cost estimates in order to facilitate negotiation of the associated fees (e.g. labor costs, direct costs, etc).

The "on-call" agreement will cover an approximate three (3) year period renewable annually beginning with the date of execution. The services will be used for both state and federal projects.

Clarendon County Transportation Committee Request to Self-Administer

On January 12, 2007, the Clarendon County Council, which also serves as the County Transportation Committee (CTC), requested to become self-administered as prescribed in the amendments to Section 12-28-2740 of the SC Code of Laws. Presently, nineteen of the forty six County Transportation Committees are self-administered.

In addition, the CTC updated its transportation plan to indicate that it would be self-administered. This plan is attached for review and approval as well.

Clarendon County Transportation Plan

(Revised January, 2007)

The Clarendon County Transportation Committee accepts responsibility to administer its "C" Funds for Clarendon County effective February 1, 2007, as prescribed in the Amendments to Section 12-28-2740 of the SC Code of Laws.

There are thirty-four (34) miles of interstate roads, one hundred thirty-four (134) miles of primary paved roads, six hundred thirty (630) miles of secondary paved roads and one hundred seventy-three bridges in Clarendon County maintained by the South Carolina Department of Transportation. Clarendon County maintains approximately six hundred forty-three (643) miles of unpaved dirt roads and approximately twelve (12) miles of paved roads. All paved roads and streets in municipalities are maintained by the South Carolina Department of Transportation.

The Clarendon County Transportation Committee will consider input from citizens of the County and from County and Municipal officials. The Clarendon County Transportation Committee may receive recommendations for resurfacing and bridge replacement needs from the South Carolina Department of Transportation. Consideration will be given to needs in municipalities and rural areas. Further, consideration will be given to resurfacing needs and new construction.

The Clarendon County Transportation Committee has established a three (3) member sub-committee to evaluate and recommend road paving lists each year. This sub-committee consists of the Clarendon County Engineer, the Clarendon County Public Works Director and the Clarendon County SCDOT Maintenance Engineer. A rating system, using various criteria, has been developed to aid in evaluating needs and setting priorities for individual roads. It is realized that there may be emergencies or other specific needs, such as industrial roads, school roads and recreational roads, that may arise and be worthy of consideration.

The Clarendon County Transportation Committee will cooperate with other County Transportation Committees in adjacent counties when it is mutually beneficial to have transportation facilities cross county lines.

EXTENSION OF BITUMINOUS RESURFACING CONTRACTS

TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL RESURFACING WORK

It is recommended that the Commission approve the action of the Department in extending existing bituminous contracts to include additional resurfacing work as follows:

ORANGEBURG COUNTY: (Commissioner Marvin Stevenson)

Contract of Rea Contracting, LLC – File No. 38.290702 – extended to include full depth patching (File No. 9.290702) on S-743 from US 176 to SC 210 and S-1376 from SC 310 to SC 452 for 3.88 miles.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 31,470.00

This extension is being requested in order to take advantage of the remaining contract quantities in this project.

SPARTANBURG COUNTY: (Commissioner F. Hugh Atkins)

Contract of Mar-King, Inc. – File No. 42.200601 – extended to include maintenance pavement markings (File No. 42.200601) on 28 roads for a total of 48.48 miles.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 0

This extension is being paid for by various underruns of the contract and the deletion of 19 roads.

This extension was authorized by the Department prior to formal approval by the Commission since the adjacent work had reached such a stage of completion that the contractors involved could not accept the additional work unless it were authorized without delay.

Recommendations: February 2007

EXTENSION OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

It is recommended that the Commission approve the action of the Department in extending existing construction contracts to include additional work as follows:

GREENVILLE COUNTY: (Commissioner F. Hugh Atkins)

Contract of U.S. Constructors, Inc. – File No. 23.327A – extended to include additional sections of Federal Project BIU-IIBM(013) (File No. 23.327A) consisting of full depth patching and resurfacing on I-385 northbound off-ramp at SC 418.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 69,424.90

The Value Engineering Proposal savings will fund this extension.

OCONEE COUNTY: (Commissioner Marion P. Carnell)

Contract of Ashmore Brothers, Inc. – File 37.144B – extended to include additional sections of Federal Project STP-RMT5(017) (File 4.171B) consisting of milling, buildup, and overlay to correct elevation on SC 59.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 27,652.15

The payment for this extension will come from the one percent total contract reduction as approved by the Director of Construction.

These extensions were authorized by the Department prior to formal approval by the Commission since the adjacent work had reached such a stage of completion that the contractors involved could not accept the additional work unless it were authorized without delay.

Removal of Roads From State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends Commission approval for the removal of certain sections of secondary roads from the State Highway Secondary System. These sections of roads may be removed for one of the following reasons:

1. Abandonment of Relocated Section of Highway
2. Deletions and Removal of Roads from State Secondary System - Roads may be deleted and removed from secondary system by exchanging for equal or less mileage or roads, which have a higher traffic importance. Ownership reverts to local government having jurisdiction (city or county). Approval of deletion or removal by local government is not required.
3. Abandonment of Right-of-way - Right-of-way may be abandoned if it is determined that the right-of-way is not required for right-of-way proposes or if the right-of-way is not needed for Department purposes.
4. Court Order

Correction of Description of State Highways

The Department recommends Commission approval of the correction of the description of sections of State Highway previously added to the State Highway System. The description of roads currently in the State Highway Secondary System may be changed for relocation purposes, to revise the description of the termini to show what was actually constructed by contract, county line changes, or a change in the secondary road number.

Additions to State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends Commission approval to add sections of road to the State Highway Secondary System for construction and maintenance. The Department may add roads to the State Highway Secondary System by request of the County Transportation Committees contingent on mileage being available under the current mileage cap. Roads may be added to the State Secondary System by the construction of a new roadway, accepting existing county/city roads into our Secondary System by the swap method, or by county line changes. Roads added to the State Highway System must be constructed to Department standards or reviewed for compliance with Department standards.

Rescind Action Adding Roads to State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends the Commission rescind its previous actions adding roads to the State Highway Secondary System for construction and maintenance. The Department may rescind action on roads, which have not been constructed and formally accepted into the State Highway Secondary System. Roads may be rescinded due to right-of-way being unavailable, problems arising during construction, or funding issues.

Transfer of Road between Secondary and Primary Systems

The Department recommends Commission approval to transfer sections of road from the Secondary System to the Primary System, or vice versa. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 57-5-50 of the Code-of-Laws of South Carolina, 1976, the Commission may transfer any route or section of route from the state highway secondary system to the state highway primary system, or vice versa, when, in its judgment, such transfer is advisable to better serve the traveling public.

Detailed information concerning each of these requests is attached.



MOTION TO AMEND BYLAWS TO PROVIDE THAT DIRECTOR OF AUDITS REPORTS DIRECTLY TO COMMISSION

The Personnel Committee makes a motion that the Commission Bylaws be amended to provide that the Director of Audits shall report to, be hired and terminated by, and be evaluated by the Commission, in coordination with the Director of Human Resources. The proposed amendments are as follows:

Section 100, "General Powers" shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 100. General Powers

The affairs of the Commission shall be managed under the direction of its members. It shall be a general policy making body for the various functions and purposes of the South Carolina Department of Transportation as prescribed by law. It and the Director shall govern the South Carolina Department of Transportation by the Commission defining policies which are to be administered by the Director. All other personnel of the Department, with the exception of the Director of Audits who shall report to, be hired and terminated by, and be evaluated by the Commission, in coordination with the Director of Human Resources, subject to grievance rights under State Employee Grievance Procedures, shall be appointed, promoted, disciplined or removed by the Director under a Merit System of Personnel Administration, job classifications and pay grades in accordance with the State Personnel and Classifications Plan and the State Employee Grievance Procedures; except that Code 57-1-450 provides that the Deputy Directors for each division serve at the pleasure of the Director and may receive compensation as established under the provisions of Code 8-11-64 and for which funds have been authorized in the general appropriations act. The Director shall conduct, execute and manage the day to day affairs of the Department and shall have all of the powers of the Commission it is not in session.

Section 110, "Powers and Duties of the Director," Paragraphs 4 and 6 shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 110. Powers and Duties of the Director

4. The Director shall have the sole authority to employ and discharge Department employees, subject to such applicable laws, applicable personnel policies and funding available for that purpose, with the exception of the Director of Audits who shall be employed and discharged by the Commission.

6. The Director shall have general supervision over and direction of all other officers and employees of the Department, with the exception of the Director of Audits, and to see that their respective duties are properly performed.
