V21 is out there – margins were reset to 1", so I had to narrow them again. It threw off some formatting, but don't worry about bullets. I wrote 2 quick macros ALT-CTL-A aligns the "recommended appropriations" and "Provisos" headers and ALT-CTL-Z aligns bullets, so I'll hit all of those quickly as I insert charts into sections.

I think I figured the best process for inserting charts sizes, etc. for the margins so I am going to eat some lunch then come back in at start pasting away – all the formatting on the excel side is complete and it's time to just put them all in. Just make sure that when you save the document it's macro-enabled. We can get rid of them tonight after all of the fixes are done but I need them for now. I'll be at the office for about another 30 min then I am going home to work. If I don't hear from you, I'll email telling you I am back in the document.
