M I N U T E S

Mr. Rhodes called the meeting to order and Councilman Curtis Kinley gave the invocation.

Mr. Kinley stated that all the work being done at the Airport was legitimate and that it was an over-run from the grant money left over and the County was supposed to do a certain amount of work for the County's part of the matching grant funds and recommended that the County start back work immediately. Mr. Kinley's motion was seconded by Mr. Hooper. Vote was unanimous.

Mr. Lusk explained the setting of the County's millage for 1982-83. He stated that the millage was: General Fund--18½ mills, Debt Service--4 mills- County Fire--2-3/4 mills, County Libraries--2 mills, Tri-County Technical College--1-3/4 mills for a total of 29 mills. On the motion of Mr. Kinley, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to send a letter to the County Auditor directing her to levy and the Treasurer to collect the above millage rates for the various funds.

Mr. Lusk presented second reading of Ordinance #99 (Sewer Authority). On the motion of Mr. Kinley, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted three in favor and one opposed. Mr. Bratcher voted against the motion.

Mr. Hooper read Ordinance #101 for approval on first reading (providing for the office of County Administrator and Council-Administrator Form of Government). On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted two in favor and two opposed adopting on first reading Ordinance #101. Mr. Rhodes voted in favor to break the tie.

Mr. Hooper discussed Boyd Street that was in bad condition. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to repair this road as soon as possible.

Mr. B.B. Bleckley discussed the Resolution calling for the Administrator-Council form of government. He stated that turning down a man who was elected by the people to serve four years didn't seem logical to him. He also discussed the letter from Mr. Lynch regarding the road in question. Mr. Lynch stated that it was not a County road.

Mr. Gilreath discussed minor changes needed to the Sewer Ordinance.

Mr. Watson discussed replacing light fixtures in the Courthouse that have deteriorated. He stated that 22 fixtures would need to be replaced at an estimated cost of \$3520.00. Mr. Rhodes asked Mr. Jordan to get with Mr. Watson and check this out for the County.

Mr. Walters asked Council for additional funds for road paving (acct. #310.35). On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to transfer \$10,000 into the acct. #310.35 until the next scheduled meeting.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, Council adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
