At the County meetings for Adopt a Highway volunteers, I have learned that there is only one paid crew for the entire Aiken County. It seems that fast food restaurants should take some part in encouraging customers to be responsible and maybe that could be pursued. A Bottle Bill similar to those in many states you see listed on the cans and bottles is a proven incentive to reducing litter of returnable bottles and cans. But mostly, it would be great if people could be put to work at minimum wage to help out with this massive job.

Yesterday I drove from Aiken to Augusta along Rt. 278 and it was the worst I have ever seen. I would honestly not want my friends and relatives visiting from Massachusetts to see this. It is so embarrassing. As soon as we crossed the border into Georgia, litter was barely noticeable. Why?

Please make this disgraceful problem a priority. I moved here from Massachusetts seven years ago and I have seen the problem increase enormously in that time. I spend some time driving through Arizona and never experience it. There must be a solution. I want to be proud of my adopted state again. Thanks you for your consideration.
