RE: Lebanon Road Speed Limit

Dear Supervisor Peagler:

Thank you for your recent letter to Governor Haley regarding the speed limits along S-47 (Lebanon Road) and S-309 (Fish Road) in Berkeley County. Your request was forwarded to my office for review and response.

Since your letter to Governor Haley on May 12, 2016, the Department collected additional data along the length of Lebanon Road and agreed to lower the speed limit to 50 mph based on existing roadway conditions. The speed limit signs were installed on May 27.

The Department has coordinated with Berkeley County in recent months regarding the speed limit on Fish Road. Due to the current condition of the roadway, it was determined that the best approach would be to temporarily install 45 mph signs until the road can be resurfaced. At that time, the 45 mph speed limit signs are to be removed, and the roadway may be reevaluated to determine the appropriate speed limit.
