Nominees may include small business owners who have lead efforts to hire workers with disabilities; managers who have developed effective workplace initiatives for people with disabilities; entrepreneurs with significant disabilities who have established successful businesses; leaders who have disclosed hidden disabilities and have initiated efforts to educate others about employment of people with disabilities; and partnerships between employers and governments that have developed effective collaborative initiatives focused on increasing competitive integrated employment.
