SC Nursery and Landscape Association to Meet in Myrtle Beach

The South Carolina Nursery & Landscape Association will hold its annual trade show and seminar on February 8-10, 2001 at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center in Myrtle Beach, SC. The program topics include: "Options for Lost Chemicals", Niche Marketing In South Carolina, Weed Control, Root and Crown Rot of Hosta, and Principles of Perennial Design. Three concurrent educational sessions will be held for landscapers, wholesalers, and retailers.

Dr. Allan Armitage, Professor of Horticulture at the University of Georgia, teacher, researcher, world traveler and plant lover will speak on new annual varieties. Jim Wilson, one of the best known faces and voices among TV gardeners and former co-host of The Victory Garden, will speak on Container Gardening. Scott Evans, Vander Kooi and Associates, will present a special program on Managing and Communicating with a Hispanic Work force and the H2B Program.

The seminar programs will be held on Thursday, February 8. The trade show will open Friday and Saturday, February 9-10. On site registration is \$50 per person for both the seminar program and the trade show. A trade show badge only is \$15. The 260 plus booth trade show offers a wide variety of plant material, equipment, and supplies for the nursery, greenhouse and landscape industry.

The Certified Nursery Professional test will be given on Saturday, February 10. Pre-registration is required for the test.

The South Carolina Greenhouse Growers Association will hold its Annual Winter Meeting in conjunction with this event. There will be a day full of seminars on Friday, February 9, with a 2-hour break to visit the trade show. The registration fee for the SCGGA winter meeting is \$30 and includes a badge for the trade show.

Commissioner's Column

Market Bulletin Facing Changes

As we begin a New Year, we in state government are presented with the difficult challenge of maintaining efficient and effective programs and services for you, the citizens of South Carolina, while decreasing our budgets drastically. That task is especially trying for the South Carolina Department of Agriculture.

As an elected Constitutional Officer of the State of South Carolina, I have held myself accountable for spending tax dollars wisely. During my tenure, it has been my policy not to request budget increases in appropriated funds over and above what was absolutely necessary to accomplish the objectives of the agency. Since there is and has been no padding in our budget diet, there is absolutely no room to lose weight.

Recently, state agencies were asked to cut their budgets 5% to 15%. I have asked every division in our agency to find ways to make those cuts in our already bare-bones budget. It will be difficult to reduce our budget without reducing or eliminating programs, services, and staff. In order to continue to provide the *Market Bulletin* to you, we may need to make some adjustments in the publication.

The *Market Bulletin* has been a long-standing institution for farmers and non-farmers in the state. Since its establishment almost 88 years ago, the *Market Bulletin* has been a free publication. Except for a brief period during the Great Depression, the *Market Bulletin* has been published continuously since 1913. At the peak number of subscribers in every two-year cycle before the renewal process, there are about 67,000 subscribers and 20,000 advertisers who buy and sell approximately \$30 million per year in agriculture and agricultural-related items through the *Market Bulletin*.

What does the budget cut proposal mean to you as subscribers and advertisers? In light of the 5% to 15% budget cuts, we have only two options before us, as we see it, and we would appreciate your preferences on both of these.

The first option would entail limiting the *Bulletin* to 12 issues per year. What this means is that instead of receiving an issue every first and third Thursday of the month, you would receive one issue per month. Some subscribers have told us that this option would reduce the *Bulletin's* effectiveness.

The second option would be for subscribers to pay a subscription fee for the *Market Bulletin*. The fee would be \$4 a year in a 5% budget cut or \$10 a year in a 10% to 15% budget cut. If we charge a fee for each subscription, the number of issues could remain at twenty-four.

The primary purpose of the *Market Bulletin* is to provide an avenue for agricultural marketing. In order to make the best decisions regarding the *Market Bulletin*, I ask that you let us know how you feel about this dilemma.
