Board of Directors, Task Force members and Donors:

Please find the attached map of the 3 day ReBuild Together home repair event, which begins tomorrow at 8am.

Over 3 days, 400 volunteers will be descending on these homes, under the respective leadership of Home Works of America and St. Bernard Project.

- homes in GREEN are receiving roof replacement and repair, under the leadership of Home Works staff
- homes in BLUE received extensive flooding damage and are no longer owner occupied, under the leadership of St. Bernard Project.
- homes in RED are receiving Mold Remediation treatment and early construction tasks related to rebuilding

(some are owner occupied, some are not).

While Home Works and St. Bernard Project are partnering together to lead the 400 volunteers, all volunteers have come through Home Works to participate in this event.

You are more than welcome to stop by any of these projects. I will be in and out of the office, visiting sites, and engaging volunteers. Home Works employees will be spread out in the field, working on homes #1-4. Please call me at 803.609.1731 if you desire to visit a site together. Otherwise, freely visit any site of your choosing.
