- WorkKeys assessments (Applied Mathematics, Reading for Information, Locating Information, and Talent)
- National Career Readiness Certificate and National Career Readiness Certificate Plus
- Career Ready 101 (a tutorial training courseware, which includes KeyTrain)
- Job profiles for South Carolina businesses will be conducted by an SC ACT authorized Job Profiler

In order to get the ball rolling--i.e., access to these no-cost services, High Schools, Career Centers and public workforce entities (LWIBs, COGs, Technical Colleges), not currently WSP's, will be required to complete an online application during the upcoming enrollment period beginning July 8-July 19, 2013.
