Commissioner's Column

Bringing farms and cities together

Susan Clifton goes to work each day to promote and market her company's vegetables. And as an employee for a business that wholesales and packages leafy vegetables and green onions year-round, her job at Walter P. Rawl & Sons, Inc., in Pelion is deeply rooted in agriculture. But Susan has now added a new dimension to her work experience—behind-the-scenes knowledge about how to get a letter from New York to Washington state overnight.

Joe Brawley is a community relations businessman at UPS who spends each day working for a company whose goal is to deliver packages on time. But Joe, too, has expanded his knowledge base, and now knows a little something about growing, harvesting, packaging and transporting the leafy vegetables Susan markets everyday.

Why should either of these professionals take time to learn about the other's job? It's just a part of a job exchange program in which many counties participate during Farm-City Week.

Farm-City Week begins Nov. 19 and lasts until Thanksgiving. It's a time for farmers and other businessmen who work outside of agriculture to try and understand how the other half lives and works. The Kiwanis International Agriculture and Conservation Committee first celebrated Farm-City Week in 1955. It's traditionally celebrated in the seven days that precede Thanksgiving, a fitting tie-in to the holiday, which recognizes our good fortune in having an abundance of food. The week was developed to highlight the interdependence of urban and rural residents, to remind us that we are "Partners in Progress."

Susan and Joe spoke at Lexington County's Farm-City banquet to let others know about their experience and their newfound respect for each other's occupation. But Lexington County by far isn't the only county with a successful Farm-City Week program. Many counties in the state do something to bring farm and city together.

In Darlington, every third-grade student in the county spent a day at the Darlington Raceway feeding chickens, ducks and sheep, among other animals at the petting zoo. They also visited other hands-on displays set up at the raceway, including vegetable, nutrition, farm equipment and crop displays. For many of these children, it was the first time they'd seen these crops and animals up close. Other students in Darlington County decorated their classroom doors with items and pictures that showed "The Farm is Where the Food is Born," not the grocery store.

Former Clemson University Head Football Coach Danny Ford helped Lee County celebrate the occasion, and local radio celebrity Jonathan Rush spoke at Saluda's annual banquet. But Saluda still has more to come, with the Taste and See event at the Saluda National Guard Armory and the Youth Agricultural Tour for the county's fourth graders.

No matter what type of activity each county chooses, they all highlight how farms and nonagricultural businesses are important to our lives. And some folks learned how they interrelate. Joe said he wasn't sure what he would learn when he spent a half-day at Rawl & Sons. After all, what could you learn in three hours? But as he watched how company employees harvested, packed and shipped vegetables, he realized that their business wasn't all that different from UPS.

"I really didn't know what to expect, and then everything started coming together," he said. "It's a multi-dimensional operation, including the transportation," Joe said. "It kind-of reminded me of UPS."

That statement from Joe shows me that the Farm-City programs across the state are accomplishing their goal—increasing public knowledge about the farming community.

The South Carolina Department of Agriculture is having a Farm-City Week celebration of its own. Beginning next week, the 1999 Art and Agriculture Watercolor Collection will be on exhibit at the Dan Ramage Conference Center on Bluff Road near the entrance of the Columbia State Farmers Market. The permanent collection consists of 37 watercolor paintings depicting various agricultural scenes.

Each year the Friends of Agriculture uses the paintings to print an art calendar. This year the members of the S.C. Future Farmers of America are selling the calendars to raise funds for their respective chapters and for a student scholarship. The Art and Agriculture Watercolor Collection and the calendars are great ways to build agricultural awareness not just during Farm-City Week, but throughout the year.

Farming is an art in itself. So, as Farm-City Week begins this weekend, let's not only remember those who are gifted and artistic, but also those who have the God-given talent to provide us with the food, fiber, and shelter that we need every day of the year.

You can support your county's Farm-City Week activities or just tell a farmer or agribusiness man or woman that you appreciate what they do for you and your family. And, to each of you have a very warm and meaningful Thanksgiving!

Tips for your live Christmas tree

Live Christmas trees bring your holiday season to life with their beauty and fragrance, both of which put many of us in the Christmas spirit. Here are a few tips from Clemson University for picking out and caring for your tree:

- If you choose a previously-cut tree, ask how long ago it was cut. You want to take home the most recently cut tree. To check the tree you want for freshness, grasp a branch between your thumb and forefinger and pull it toward you. If the tree is fresh, very few needles will fall. Also, fresh tree needles spring back easily when bent. If you bump the tree on the ground and *green* needles fall, the tree isn't fresh.
- Check out the trunk of your tree. If you see splits in it, it has most likely dried to a point where it will not take up water.
- When picking your tree from a field, remember that pines, firs and Leyland Cypress stay fresh longer than other trees. Cedars, spruces and cultivars of Arizona cypress stay fresh for a shorter period of time.
- If your tree has been cut for more than an hour, recut at least 1 inch from the trunk and place the tree in plain water immediately. Don't expose the tree to freezing temperatures.
- Make sure the tree's container has enough capacity to keep the trunk in water all the time. A fresh tree may use more than a gallon of water a day.
- Check the water level *every day*. If the water ever dries out, the tree loses its ability to take up water, and adding water after this point doesn't do much good.
- Heat will dry out your tree, so keep it away from heat sources such as hot air ducts, radiators, fireplaces and television sets.
- Avoid combustible decorations, always turn off your decorations before going to bed or leaving home, never place candles or other open flame sources on or near your tree, test your light cords before you put them on your tree.

Horsemen ready for Manchester

The S.C. Horsemen's Council is excited about this weekend's trail ride at Manchester State Forest in Sumter County.

The annual ride, located off Hwy. 261, will begin at 10 a.m. on Saturday, Nov. 20, but the fun begins Friday night. A DJ with karaoke, line dancing and two-step lessons are on Friday night's agenda. After the trail ride Saturday, there will be a barbecue dinner as well a dancing with One Step Ahead.

Tickets are \$20 for SCHC members and \$23 for nonmembers; children under 10 will be admitted free if accompanied by a parent. To avoid long lines, tickets should be purchased in advance. Camping will be available Friday through Sunday. Call 803-734-2187 for ticket information.

Crop sign-up period announced

The 20th Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) sign-up will be Jan. 18 through Feb. 11. The purpose of CRP is to plant trees or grasses on environmentally sensitive cropland. Producers with approved CRP contracts receive annual rental payments for a 10-to-15-year period. In addition, producers receive cost-share assistance to plant the enrolled acreage on a permanent cover. South Carolina currently has about 200,000 acres enrolled in CRP. Nationally, the Farm Service Agency is authorized to maintain CRP enrollment up to 36.4 million acres. About 400,000 acres now under contract will expire Sept. 30, 2000. CRP is a very competitive program and interested producers should contact their local FSA agency for details.

News from the USDA

• Farmers and other landowners can receive financial and technical assistance for resource conservation through three upcoming programs.

The programs, offered by the National Resource Conservation Service, **offer landowners incentives to practice conservation on their lands**. Each program offers many conservation options to landowners.

The Environmental Quality Incentives Program shares costs with landowners who improve conservation on their lands. The Wetland Reserve Program focuses on restoring wetlands and improving waterfowl and wildlife habitats. You can sign up for these programs through Dec. 15. The Forestry Incentives Program encourages landowners to restore our forest resources by practicing reforestation, timberstand improvement and other methods of forest management. The deadline to sign up for this program is Feb. 29, 2000. To sign up, call your local USDA Service Center or (803) 765-5686.

• Upstate trout streams and wetland wildlife will soon get a \$40,000 boost from the USDA.

Partners for Trout and the S.C. Partners Project will each receive \$20,000 to improve wetland wildlife conditions. Partners for Trout works to conserve, enhance and restore South Carolina's cold-water trout habitats and fish stocks. Trout fishing generates about \$17 million annually in the northwestern corner of the state, where there are 250 miles of trout streams. But rapid development in the upstate has jeopardized trout waters there, a situation Partners for Trout hope to change.

The S.C. Partners Project will provide assistance to owners of intact and remnant rice plantation wetland systems to improve habitats for wading birds, waterfowl and shorebirds.

Roasted Mini-Pumpkins

Ingredients: 12 mini-pumpkins, 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon, 1/8 teaspoon nutmeg, 1/8 teaspoon ground allspice, 6 tablespoons unsalted butter, 1/4 cup pure maple syrup, salt and freshly ground black pepper.

Directions: Preheat oven to 400°. Using sharp paring knife, cut a ring around each pumpkin stem to form a lid; remove the lids and set aside. With a small spoon, scrape out the seeds and any membranes. In a small bowl, combine the cinnamon, nutmeg and allspice. Sprinkle the spices inside the pumpkins. Add 1/2 tablespoon butter and 1 teaspoon maple syrup to each pumpkin and season with salt and pepper. Set the pumpkins in a baking dish and add 1/2 in. water. Replace the lids and roast the pumpkins for about 30 min. or until tender. Serve hot. 12 servings.
