

Mission Statement

Alert Inc. is a Non for Profit organization specifically formed to better protect faculty and students in learning institutions nationally and globally. The charity is privately funded and does not accept any government monies, nor does it ask for any. Alert Inc. solely stands on its own from individual donations. 100% of the donations received by Alert Inc. go to the cause. All of Alert Inc.'s employees are volunteers and donate their time to the cause. Our staff consists of handicapped students, law enforcement and security experts.

Alert Inc. along with the school faculty, student body, and local law enforcement will come up with a comprehensive plan and security protocol for each institution to better protect that facility. This will be performed by installing better locks, cameras, hardened doors and glass on a case by case basis, anything that can delay someone wanting to cause harm from entering that institution or classroom. This gives law enforcement the precious moments to get there in time before a tragedy actually happens. Keeping the faculty and students out of harm's way and keeping casualties to a minimum, if any. April 21st is designated as National Alert Day. This day, April 21st and the first Thursday of November in each school year should be used the way fire drills are, to practice the schools drill in case of an unforeseen event.

Our aim is to get one of our local law enforcement volunteers to partner with one school from their sector, and get to know the school inside and out. Just in case of an emergency they would know exactly where to go, and the quickest way to stop the threat. The main goal is to better protect these learning institutions from terror, whether it be from within or an outside source of threat and get the institution a quicker response time. The learning institution will be a far safer place because of Alert Inc., its volunteers, local law enforcement, equipment and cooperation from each and every educational institution across the nation and around the world.
