As I am sure you are aware, FOIA actually prohibits the release of information relating to security plans and devices and specifically excludes such from the definition of "public record." However, in reviewing the attached materials, it does not appear that either of these documents meet this criteria. As such, SLED has no concern with the release of either document. Should you ever need it, the security plan language from § 30-4-20(c) is below:

"Information relating to security plans and devices proposed, adopted, installed, or utilized by a public body, other than amounts expended for adoption, implementation, or installation of these plans and devices, is required to be closed to the public and is not considered to be made open to the public under the provisions of this act."

I appreciate the heads up on this one, and please don't hesitate to let me know if I can ever be of further assistance.
