M I N U T E S

Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Councilman Curtis Kinley gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to approve the January 20, 1981 minutes as mailed.

Mr. Cecil Howard, Manager of the S.C. State Employment Office, appeared before Council asking for some space on the Farmer's Market Lot to place a small building to be used as a day labor pick up point. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to allow the State Employment Office to use the space at Mr. Poore's discretion. Motion was amended by Mr. Bratcher to include that the Employment Office be allowed to use for 12 months and then Council would see how the agreement was working. Council voted unanimously on the motion.

Mr. Charles Whiten, Anderson County Public Defender, asked Council for \$1800.00 to fund an employee through June, 1981. The CETA employee which was not placed on County payroll in the 1980-81 FY budget would be needed to handle the Juvenile Program which is going on. Mr. Poore explained the financial situation of the County and that there was no monies anywhere in which to fund the position. No action was taken.

Mr. Doyle Kay, Director of the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Commission, appeared before Council requesting permission to fill a vacancy (Mr. Butch Moore) on the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Commission's Board by Ms. Mozelle Rice Marshall. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted 4 in favor and 1 against nominating Mr. John Raftakis to the Board. Mr. Bratcher voted against the motion. Mr. Bratcher made a motion to nominate Ms. Mozelle Rice Marshall to the vacancy. His motion died from lack of second.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council vote 4 in favor and 1 against (Mr. Wright voted against the motion.) to fund the Anderson County Mental Health \$25,000. Mr. Hooper explained that \$10,000 would be transferred from account (EMS number 460 object 84 (Machines & Equipment) and the remaining \$15,000 would come from account #850 object 79 (Direct Assistance-Workman's Compensation).

Mr. Rhodes explained Ordinance #62 (County Audits) which would require all dependent boards, agencies, commissions, etc., fully or partially funded by Anderson County to furnish a complete audit to the County Council and a detailed budget before they could receive additional money for the following year. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to adopt Ordinance #62 on first reading.

Mr. James R. Thornton, representing Richard B. Russell Dam Project, asked Council to sign a contract that would allow for relocation of a bridge near Fellowship Road. He stated that the contract had nothing to do with the assess points for the lake. On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to sign the contract.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to adjourn at 9:40 a.m.
