The State Budget and Control Board met in the office of the State Auditor at 11:00 A. M. on December 10 to continue its study of the 1955-56 budget. Board members Bates, Rhodes and Verner were present at this meeting. Governor-elect Timmerman was also present.

After some discussion the Budget as prepared by the State Auditor, and embodying such changes as were agreed upon by the Board, was finally approved and ordered printed.

The Board approved payment to John W. Thomas of \$171.23 to cover his official expense to a conference on Uniform State Laws held in New York during the past summer.

The Board authorized the State Treasurer to have the interior of his office repainted at a cost of \$290.00, same to be paid from the Civil Contingent Fund.

The Board agreed to supply funds to Clemson College, Livestock Sanitary Division, up to the sum of \$30,000.00, to cover indemnities payable to owners of swine which were ordered to be slaughtered when found to be infected with vesicular exanthema.

The Board further agreed to provide funds to the Governor's office necessary to cover the expense of the office to June 30, 1955.

The Board also agreed to provide funds necessary to purchase a new automobile for the use of the Governor with the beginning of the next term.

The Board further agreed to defray expenses incurred in connection with the inauguration of Governor Timmerman.

The Board then adjourned.
